MEET MCTIQUE

Berlenbach Morally Bound to
Fight Former Title Holder
Athletic Commission Thinks.

NEW YORK, Jan. 26 (AP)—Paul Berlenbach, world's light heavyweight champion, is morally bound to give Mike McTigue, former title holder, a return match before he engages in another contest in this state. This ruling was made by the state athletic commission today, after reviewing the case, following Berlenbach's refusal to sign for the match. Berlenbach has six months in which to accept the challenge.

The board also ruled it had selected Bushy Graham of Tulsa, N. Y., as the outstanding challenger for the bantamweight title and that Charlie (Phil) Brown, title holder, must fight Graham on or before March 19, the date selected for the match by Jesse McMahon, matchmaker at Madison Square Garden.

In commenting on Berlenbach's case, Chairman Farley said Berlenbach made a verbal promise to give McTigue a return match in the event he succeeded in lifting the crown.

BODY OF WOMAN FOUND
AFTER HUSBAND TELLS
OF CAUSING HER DEATH

MONTROSE, Colo., Jan. 26 (AP)—The body of Mrs. Edna E. Baird was found in a shallow grave, covered with less than three inches of earth on her husband's ranch near Safford, Colorado, late today after Baird confessed to authorities that he killed her on December 2, 1925.

Baird said he had threatened to shoot his wife with a .22 caliber rifle and he had done so. Baird was the woman's fourth husband. Her second husband, William Partridge, died in 1915, under circumstances that later led to the conviction of her son for a forgery marriage on a charge of murdering Partridge with a knife.

TRANS ATLANTIC AIR VOYAGE
FROM SPAIN TO ARGENTINA IS
UNDER WAY. WILL TAKE TWO
DAY REST AT PORTO PRATA.

PORTO PRATA, Cape Verde Islands, Jan. 26 (AP)—The Spanish aviators today completed the second stage of their flight from Canary Islands to Porto Prata, on the trans-Atlantic air voyage from Spain to Argentina.

Commander Franco and his fellow aviators argued the flight from Gando bay, the Canaries, to this point in about nine hours. With an early morning start the plane came to rest in the early evening, and those who had gathered to witness the arrival were given to understand that all had been well throughout the entire flight.

The commander and his comrades will take a two days' rest to prepare for the long trip to Pernambuco, Brazil, if possible, or to Fernando de Noronha island, should the fuel supply fail to last long enough to permit a non-stop flight to Pernambuco, a distance of more than 1,200 miles. They intend to take off from here at nightfall, flying by the light of the moon, and expect to reach the Brazilian coast the following evening.

Three Spanish warships, the Alvaro, Don Blas de Lezo and the Infante Isabel, will guard the route of the longest flight yet attempted by the aviators. They already have covered 1,872 miles over the ocean, which is more than half the distance between Spain and South America.

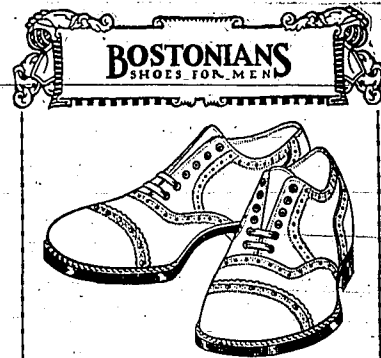
