TAX CONCERNS IN AGREEMENT ON REDUCTION

Cut of \$381,000,000 for This Year and \$343,000,000 Thereafter Decided Upon at House and Senate Conference

(By the Associated Press) WASHINGTON, Feb. 19 (AP)—Tax reduction amounting to \$381,000,000 this year and \$343,000,000 thereafter was agreed upon today by senate and house conferees on the revenue bill.

The compromise, which must be ratified by Congress, provides for a cut of \$381,000,000 in 1926 and \$343,000,000 in 1927. The compromise measure will be reported to the house for ratification Monday or Tuesday. If approved it will be taken to the senate the following day and upon its approval the bill will be sent to the president for signature.
