

YANKEES HOLD TITLES BATTLE

Struggle Between East and West for Premier Honors of Baldwin Shifts From Mississippi Shores to Harlem.

AIKEN, S. C., Oct. 8. (AP) - Mob violence flared up in Aiken today, following the killing of three negroes by a band of unidentified men, variously estimated as between 50 and 100, who shot the negroes and then fled to a nearby hill where they hid their bodies.

The position of the bodies, it is believed, indicated that the negroes had been released by the mob, ordered to run, and then shot down.

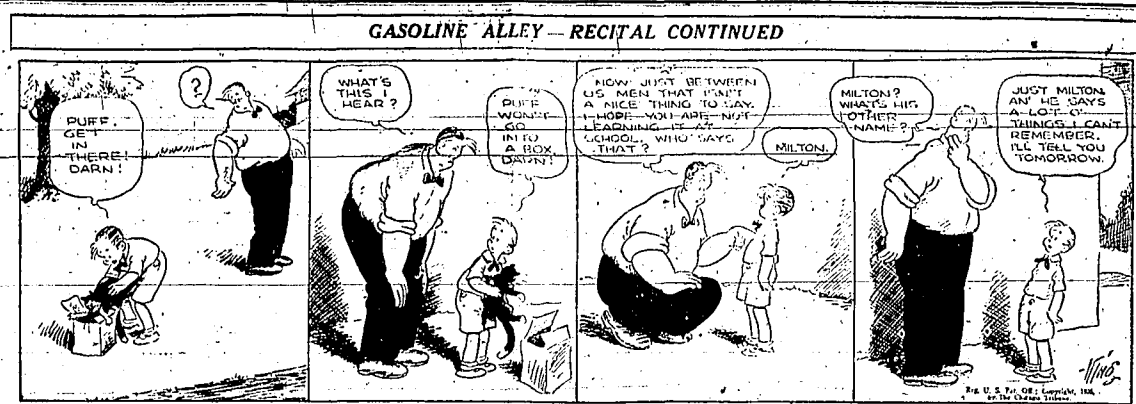
