



**B FLAMES DESTROY BOAT IN HARBOR**

**P Two Explosions Occur During Day at San Pedro; Eight Injured in First Blast.**

SAN PEDRO, Cal., Nov. 30 (AP)—A second ship explosion in this harbor day set fire to the schooner "The Swallow," a coastwise freighter, which damaged its interests.

Four sailors previously seen aboard the boat were reported missing. Earlier in the day an explosion caused the steamer "Wentwick" to burst into flames, which injured eight men.

The "Swallow" was moored near the Standard Oil loading station at the time of the explosion, scattered, having broken off a pipe which had been leaking gasoline.

One man, apparently an engineer, appeared to have been killed and another was badly injured, while another man followed him both disappearing in the darkness.

Fire boats taxed the water into mid-channel to protect the shore oil properties destroyed. The total value of the damage was \$10,000.

Chairman Farley, however, appeared as Tunney's advocate, fully consonant in his judgment of the case on condition that the police in the interim "would not break the show."


