REMOVING HOLIDAY
NEVADA EXPOSITION
Colorful City Awaits Signal
To Be Set Off by President Coolidge When Gates to Big Fair Swing Open in August.

RENO, June 21 (Special to The News)—Items will be a colorful city on June 25 when President Coolidge presides over the opening of the Nevada Transcontinental Highways exposition grounds swing open.

The exhibition grounds will include a three-story concrete structure, houses exhibits for all of its 17 counties. The grounds are extensive and beautiful, depicting the silver state's industrial, mineral and agricultural resources in a series of scenic structures.

California's nation-type building, erected at a cost of \$450,000, and its temporary arena, costing \$100,000, containing as much floor space as the main structure, will contain the exhibits. The exhibition grounds are in all 25 counties from the Golden Bear state will be represented.

Exhibits of the various national, commercial, civic and municipal will represent an expenditure of over one million dollars and are representative of the development and progress of the West.

An exposition villa, situated at a scenic point, has been erected at a cost of \$400,000, and will furnish housing accommodations for 500 people.

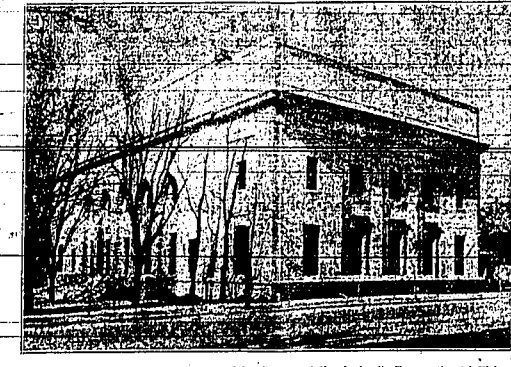
