75,000 WILL WITNESS SHARKEY-DEMPESEY FIGHT IN NEW YORK

Plans for Most Spectacular Non-Championship Fight in Ring History Complete; Battle to Be at Yankee Stadium.

(By The Associated Press) NEW YORK, July 20.—In what promises to be the most spectacular non-championship fight in the history of the ring, Jack Dempsey will battle Jack Sharkey tomorrow night at the brightly lighted championship of the world in September.

They will fight it out at the Yankee stadium in an 15-round match that has attracted so much interest and money, and which is expected to draw a record, chiefly because of the attempted comeback of the most successful champion of modern times, Dempsey.

At least 75,000 spectators, and possibly 80,000 including many outside the stadium, are expected to witness the increase of time and outburst in youthful rage. They will pay approximately \$12,000 for the privilege.

Radio microphones at the ringside will carry the word picture of the fight over a nation-wide hookup to from 15,000,000 to 20,000,000 other persons. Sharkey's rival a decided favorite tonight among the experts who have analyzed and weighed the chances of the two fighters. On the other hand, Dempsey claimed the support of popular opinion in an apparently overwhelming measure, as well as the backing of many close observers.

Experts Favor Sharkey. The experts, or rather the apparently majority favoring Sharkey, base their predictions of a victory for the rugged Boston sailor chiefly on his youth, speed and superior boxing craft. He is 25 to Dempsey's 32. He has been fighting frequently and rising rapidly on the heavyweight scale in the past year and will—with decisive triumph—over Harry Wild, Mike McEuse and Jimmy Maloney to his credit. Dempsey has fought only once in four years and then last September, a losing battle.

Dempsey, according to the expert majority supporting him, will win because he has regained his old knockout punch, shaken off the legal worries that beset him a year ago and whipped himself into a good fighting trim as it is possible for an athlete to acquire after a long period of inactivity and competition. Whatever speed has passed with his youth, they argue, will be offset by his

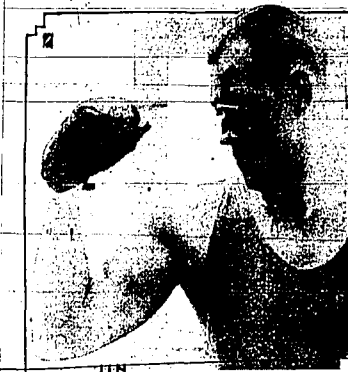

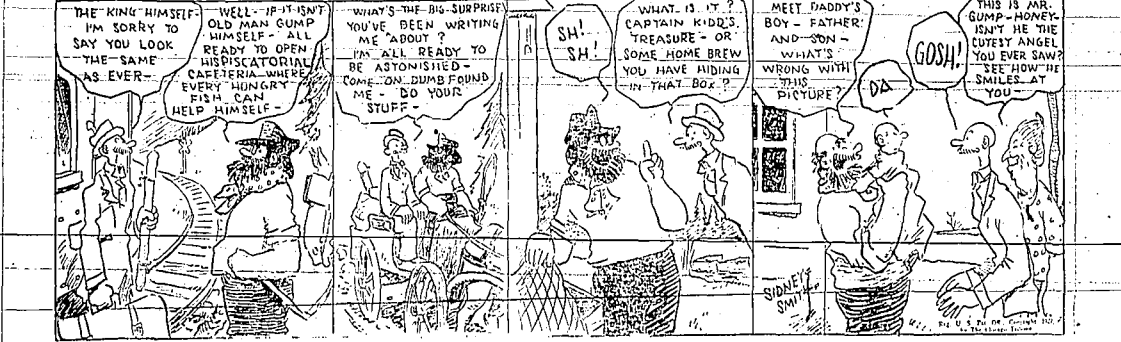

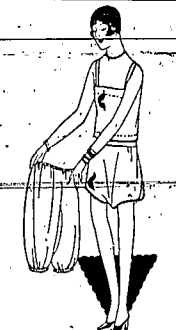
