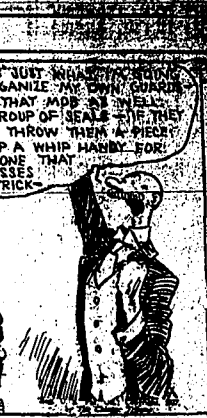

Gives Up Present Location in Elks Building and Seeks Without Success for Main Avenue Quarters.

W. H. Wright and Sons company department store on next December 31 expects to vacate quarters in the Elks building at the corner of Shoshone street and Second avenue north, which it has occupied for nearly five years.
