Litvinoff's speech on Monday for American support for the soviet project. All attention was centered on him as he began with a direct answer to the subject in these words:

"If the opinion of one of the delegates proposed a multi-lateral anti-Communist war to support the proposition now before us for immediate and complete disarmament. It is precisely on the grounds of sincerity, consistency, and logic that my government supports the idea of multi-lateral disarmament as an instrument of national policy and of the same time, it is precisely on the same grounds that it opposes the proposal for immediate and complete disarmament, which we do not believe are calculated to achieve their avowed purpose."

There were nods of approval all around the committee table except by the Germans, Russians and Turks, when Mr. Gibson went on to say:

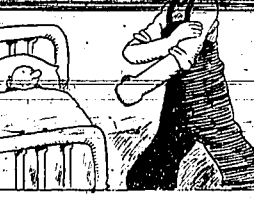
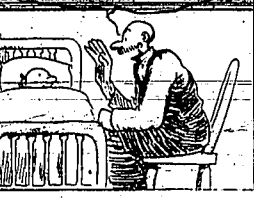
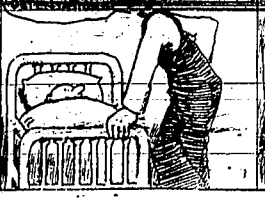

LOCAL EDITOR DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Tom Blodgett, 52, Had Varied Career in Business, Politics, Ministry and Journalism.

Tom Blodgett, 52, editor of the Idaho Citizen and president of the Citizen Publishing company, died at his home at 161 Pierce street at 2 o'clock Wednesday morning following prolonged illness. Heart disease was the immediate cause of death. Mr. Blodgett was born in St. Albans, Vermont, his birthplace. He was educated in the common schools and was engaged for a number of years in the wholesale dry goods business. Later he moved to Arkansas where he was engaged in land development and lumber business in Bismarck and land project work in Pine Bluff. Mr. Blodgett was at one time mayor of Bismarck.

Engaged in Politics. Mr. Blodgett was actively engaged in politics in Kansas in campaign for Senator Arthur Capper and William Allen White. He was also active in the interests of the Red Cross society and in gospel and educational work there. Mr. Blodgett married Miss Emma Koonitz nine years ago in her home town, Stoughton, Mass. She was an attack of influenza. Mr. Blodgett moved to Idaho in 1922. Mr. Blodgett was a ordained minister, having graduated from Hocking college, Illinois. After his arrival in Boise he became associated with the work of the Methodist Episcopal church here. He was formerly pastor of the church at Mountain Home. He was instrumental in the organization of the community church at Hansen about five years ago.

Entered Newspaper Field. Following his arrival in Twin Falls in October, 1925, Mr. Blodgett and Paul Torgler, then editor of the Citizen Publishing company. During his residence in Twin Falls Mr. Blodgett has been actively engaged in his religious and civic work in addition to his newspaper activities. Surviving the deceased is his widow, Mrs. Emma K. Blodgett, and three children, Joseph Parks, Raymond, Texas, and other relatives in Vermont. Funeral services will be conducted by Dr. H. Humphrey, Twin Falls, and Rev. W. B. Van Dusen, Boise, at the Methodist Episcopal church here at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon. The body will lie in state at the church Friday afternoon from 1:30 to 3 o'clock. Interment will be in Twin Falls cemetery. The body now lies at the White mortuary.
