PRESIDENT REQUESTS \$3,830,445,231 FOR GOVERNMENT IN 1930

Chief Executive Declares Finances of Country in Sound Condition and Renews Plea for Tax Slash

WASHINGTON, Dec. 4.—To carry forward the manifold activities of the government, President Hoover in his first annual budget message today asked congress to set aside \$3,830,445,231 for the next fiscal year.

At the same time he declared the nation's finances to be in a sound condition and renewed his plea for a speedy reduction in taxes year by year.

Mr. Hoover asked for larger sums for many important activities of the government including the army, the navy, flood control, rivers and harbors, public buildings, forest protection and judicial affairs.

Considerable space was devoted in the message to the condition of the nation's treasury, although "it was dealt with in some length in the president's annual message."

Saying the country was "warily contented" to a policy which leaves the public debt, Mr. Hoover said this debt had been decreased from its peak of \$20,800,000 on June 30, 1929.

In 1931, he added, will be reached for the first time the period when the government's expenditures will be less than its receipts.

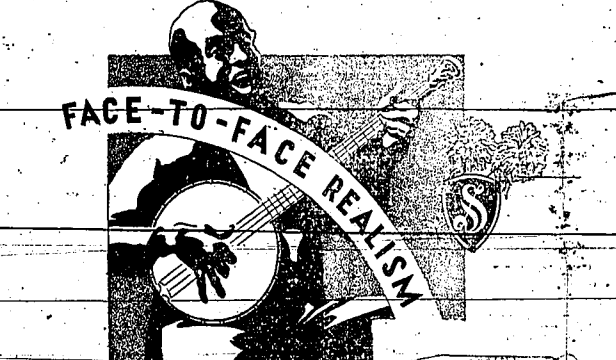

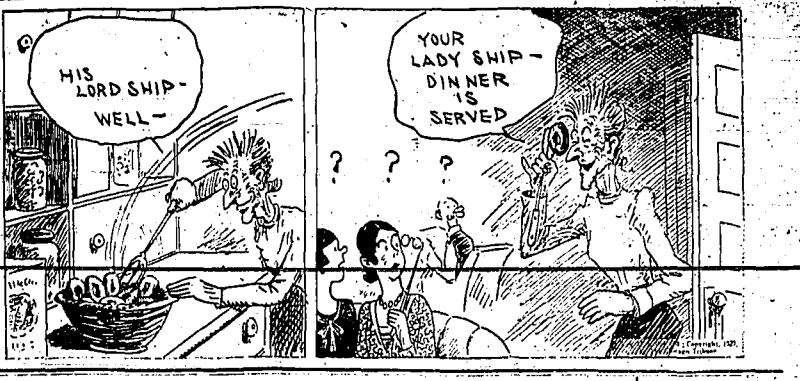

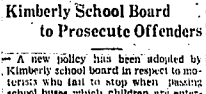
