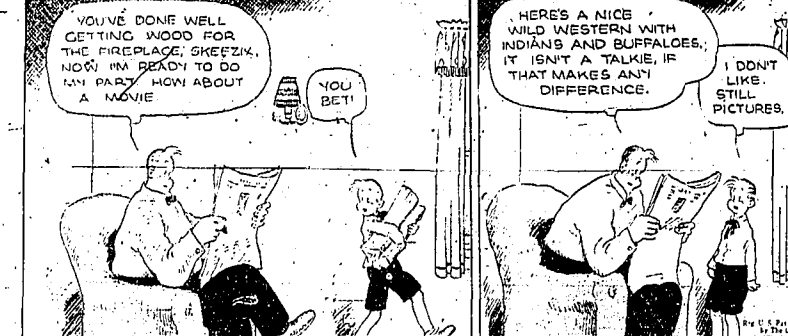

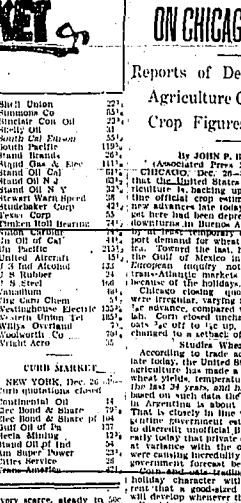

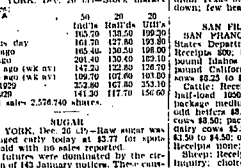

BLACKFOOT AT END OF CRIMINAL TRAIL OF PRISON FUGITIVE

Loyal Treseder, Adjudged Drug Addict, Goes to Institution For Treatment—San Quentin Waits

Loyal Treseder, 27, inmate from San Quentin, California, prison, who, according to his own admission committed burglary in doctor's office here and at Jerome and Shoshone, besides breaking into a jewelry store at Gooding and a lodging house at Kimberly during the last two months, has been committed to the Idaho state mental hospital, Blackfoot, for not less than six months. Commitment followed a hearing by Judge W. A. Emswiler in district court at which Treseder was pronounced a drug addict. Witnesses were R. E. Leighton, Twin Falls police chief, Dr. C. A. Emswiler, and M. Treseder, Ogden contractor, father of the accused young man.

The father estimated spending \$10,000 to get the young man out of scrapes during the last 12 years. Dr. Emswiler testified that since December 17 when Treseder was arrested here, his daily dose of the narcotic had been reduced gradually from 16 grains to 2 1/2 grains. Treseder's parents and Dr. Emswiler accompanied him to Blackfoot last evening. Treseder was arrested here when he was leaving one doctor's office after breaking into another to obtain a narcotic drug.

Information given to officers by Treseder since his arrest here has led to recovery of all property stolen by him in this region except one out of six diamonds rings taken at Gooding, officers here stated.

San Quentin authorities have indicated that they will issue detention warrant for Treseder and will claim him when he is released from Idaho institution, officers here stated last evening.

Treseder escaped from a San Quentin road gang of which he was former man last May. He was serving sentence for burglary in San Francisco, and had spent nine months in the prison.

After his escape he was employed at Elmer Treseder's Oregon Oregon and made his way from town to town in this region during the last several weeks in an automobile that he admitted having stolen in Nevada.

STATE CLAIMS CANAL DREDGER HURTS ROAD

Public Works Department Requests Company to Repair Highway at Filer

Examination of about three and a half miles of paved highway in the Filer highway district, alleged to have been damaged by the big dredger of the Twin Falls Canal company, was made yesterday by the Twin Falls Canal company board of directors, John E. Hayes, manager and Judge James R. Bothwell, legal adviser. The matter was brought in the attention of the board by W. D. Gillis, Boise, attorney general, representing the state department of public works, who asked the board to provide for repair of the alleged damages to the road. The state department claims that the dredger was driven over the road for a distance of 16,157 feet in violation, it is claimed, of the 1929 statute, damaging the paving to the extent, the department contends, that repair work to the value of \$10,700 will be required to prevent deterioration. Members of the canal board said last evening that they expected to ask the state department of public works to appoint a committee to confer on the subject. Judge Bothwell said last evening that one of the matters to be considered by a conference which he held, would be the question whether any damage was done to the highway by the machine used by the Twin Falls canal company, or whether it resulted entirely from other agency. He said later investigation tended to indicate that the latter explanation was the correct one.

Wife Asserts Claim to Interest in Property

Asserting her claim to property in Buhl which she declares is community property owned jointly by herself and her husband, Mrs. Ruth Gertrude Miller has instituted suit in district court here to set aside a purported contract of sale dated last December 4, under which, she alleges, transfers this property to E. Orr Chapman, Twin Falls, attorneys.
