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NINE CHILDREN DIE WHEN RAIL TRAIN PLUNGES INTO BUS

Locomotive, Pounding Along at 45 Miles Per Hour, Rins Through Vehicle, Scattering Bodies Over 500 Feet

(By The Associated Press) CLEVELAND, Jan. 22.—Unsuspecting, the heavily laden car of an onrushing New York Central mail train, nine school children and the driver of a bus in which they were riding were killed today when the train, traveling at 45 miles an hour, crashed into the bus.

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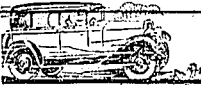
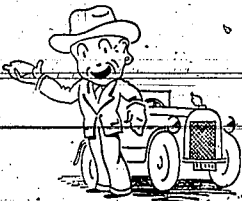

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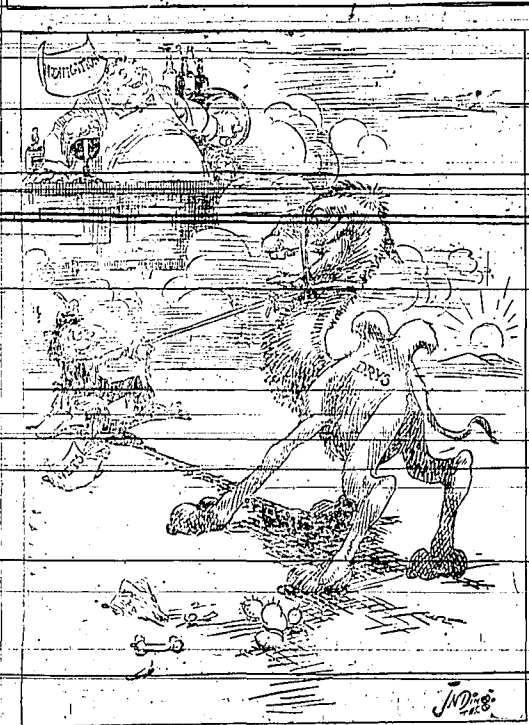
