

Idaho citizens who want to take part in the nonlination of candidates for Legislature and County officer at the primary elections on the fifth day of August, must register on a before Baturday, the twenty-sixti

day of July.

Chittens who vote only at the gen-eral election in November may reg-jacer later, but, treapective of any prior registration, under Idaho's now-election, law, every voter must reg-sister for the clections this year. There are no exceptions.

Toters in the primary election participate in a party function; whereas voters in the general efec-tion discharge what is at once the privilege and responsibility of every

privilege and responsibility of every

privilege and responsionity or every citizen.

The new law requires citizens refistering it vote in the primary elections to declare their party affiliations. 




