POTATO PRODUCTION OF COUNTRY DROPS FAR UNDER NORMAL

Department of Agriculture Experts Declare Conditions Appear Good in Gem State and Colorado

WASHINGTON, Sept. 22 (AP) - The 1930 crop of Idaho and Colorado potatoes has been placed by the department of agriculture at 9 per cent below 1929 production and 14 per cent below average production for the last five years.

Potato production now figures to total less than 30,000,000 bushels, the department said. This would be more than 50 per cent smaller than the like production of 300,000,000 last year.

The trend of drops in the more northerly states and the falling effect of the extreme temperatures during the growing season are responsible for the loss in most states.

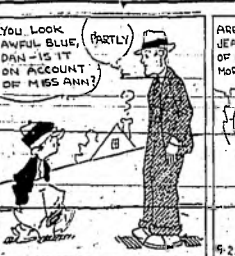

BARABY GETS LONG PRISON TERM FOR KIDNAPING CHILD

Judge A. B. Barclay Imposes Sentence of 10 to 25 years Upon Construction Worker for Crime

William Baraby, 42, better known as "Billie," was sentenced to a term of 10 to 25 years in the state prison for kidnaping of 11-year-old Lorena Cable here July 23, was sentenced by Judge Adam B.
