

England Hears Of Liberals' Plan To Remedy Unemployment

MINORITY FACTION MOVES TO RELIEVE 1,000,000 JOBLESS

National Construction Program and Agricultural Development Enter Into Proposal—to—Parliament

(By The Associated Press)

LONDON, Nov. 3.—Far-reaching plans to reduce Great Britain's number of unemployed by a million in next 12 months have been presented to the government by David Lloyd George and his Liberal colleagues, who have been in conference with Labor cabinet members during the parliamentary recess.

The plan, which was published tonight, contemplates elimination of what Lloyd George and his associates call the "refractory million," or those unemployed British workers—between 1,000,000—who represent the "excess above the numbers nominally in course of training, or individuals who have been persistent since the war."

The authors of this plan, who also gave it the title "The jobless plan," have fasted to validate their program. In effect, as follows:

First, reduction of production costs so low level which will enable British goods to compete successfully in world markets. This plan proposes about 12 per cent, varying in different industries.

The plan's second proposal is for government stimulation of new engineering developments.

Third, the Liberals suggest encouragement of agriculture could add 500,000 additional workers.

Fourth, an intensified and accelerated program of industrial development and reconstruction is proposed.

Vigorous pursuit of such a policy is manifested in connection with roads, public planting and housing, extension of the telephone system, and electrical development.

These programs will involve large expenditures, their authors admit.

"The money can be found, the nation can afford it, but it is important that the money will not pre-judge our efforts in other directions, and the expenditure will not be redundant."

IRISH HONOR ELECTRIC PROJECT WITH STAMPS

BUDGET, Nov. 3 (UPI)—A special postal stamp commemorating completion of the River Shannon electricity project is to be issued by the Free State.



NEW ORLEANS, Nov. 3.—Zanned by flood conditions in a number of states, the mighty Mississippi is being trained rapidly by Uncle Sam to serve as a patient pack horse for commerce.

Through the Inland Waterways corporation and its chief, General T. Q. Ashburn, the federal government is proving that the Mississippi properly made, can be the most common carrier as in its younger days.



COMMISSIONER OF WATERWORKS ASKS FOR MORE STORAGE

Council Takes No Action
On Recommendation For
Vote on \$90,000 Bond
Issue—For Clear Well

Along with a series of Twin Falls municipal waterworks operations during the past eight months, showing 28,200 feet of iron pipe laid, at a total cost of approximately \$102,000, Thomas Sanderson, commissioner of streets and waterworks, submitted in a report to Twin Falls city council last Friday a statement outlining the need for increased storage capacity in connection with the waterworks system.

In support of argument that additional storage was needed to improve service to the city water supply, the commissioner laid before the council a letter written by M. L. Taylor, former Twin Falls city chemist.

Council members at once entered into spirited discussion of the commissioner's recommendation, and there was considerable difference of opinion on the subject, and no action was taken in respect to the commissioner's proposal for a \$90,000 bond election.

"We can do nothing at all about it without the advice and counsel of a thoroughly competent engineer," Mayor E. H. Butler declared.

Here Is Commissioner Sanderson's Report:

"The water department, during the season from March 1, 1930, to November 1, 1930, has laid 6,073 feet of iron pipe from pipe 12½ inches to 6 inch iron pipe, 1,064 feet of 6 inch pipe, 1,064 feet of 4 inch iron pipe, making a total of 28,200 feet of iron mains laid this year."

The cost of pipe, valves and fittings, \$20,000; brass and lead, \$7,250; making a total cost of \$20,250.

Some Money Available

"We then have a total of 12,280 feet of water pipe still to be replaced, and the iron pipe we have, we will have funds available to lay 6,000 feet more of iron pipe, leaving 750 feet to be completed out of the 12,280 feet, making a total of 14,250 feet of abandoned wooden pipes. These pipes were re-banded with 3/8 inch two-piece metal bands and should have a life of eight years without giving any trouble."

"This season's replacement, with iron pipe under the supervision of Frank Paylor, head supervisor, and John Boren has been done in a highly efficient and economical manner."

"We still have the problem of a clear well or storage basin at the filter plant with the silt in the water increasing. It is becoming more and more difficult to add added storage facilities. As conditions now exist it is impossible to give the filter plant a proper and thorough cleaning. This should be done at least once a week during the hot months of June, July and August, in order to eliminate all the silt and dirt from the water. This is impossible to do without a storage basin. The filter plant would have to shut down for a week or two to do this, so, the advantage of 24 hours storage also gives the water a chance to cool off, and there is no doubt that the quality of the water would be greatly improved."

"The fire hazard should be given some consideration, also, there is always a danger of possible explosion, should a fire break out in the machinery as we well know the filter plant is taxed to capacity."

most favorable that it has been in years, this election if called should be called as soon as possible; If the election should be delayed too long, the time is none too long to get the propanekines out of the way and to build and complete the storage tank in time for winter.

"If the taxpayers of the city should see fit to defeat the bond issue, that is their business and privilege. The commissioners will then have to take other steps. The surveyor has estimated the cost of a clear well with a capacity of 4,700,000 gallons would cost \$90,000, and the heat cost of pumping water up from the base of the hill to the water tower would be prohibitive. The earnings of the water department will be able to take care of bond interest and sinking fund, so that the water department will be able to meet its minimum monthly water rental to its present schedule."

"This morning, the local company that owns the water tower in the city will be closed for three days. Our storage supply of water in the canal will probably last for about 10 days. The water should be obtained in opening the gates the canal company, for any reason, delayed in opening the gates the situation might become serious. This morning the water department is in need of storage water."

During peak months and stored water would hardly last an hour.

Consumption Increasing

The consumption of water is increasing more rapidly than in previous years. There are now an average of 50 permits for water laid each month. The amount of added storage will hardly be possible to get through another season without robbing the water system of its present storage.

In a former report, the state chemist is still urging and warning us that we should and must have a clear well or storage basin at the filter plant.

There are probably a number of sources within the city that have some hope of securing some other source to supply the city with water. Engineers have surveyed and found that the water in the various sources, but their report has not yet been unfavorable. The other sources are the wells in the south of the city, but these sources likewise is more or less of a pipe dream. Even admitting the possibility of such sources the storage of water would still be a necessity.

—Recommend Bond Election

"At this time, I earnestly recommend that the city council call a special election to vote bonds for the improvement of the city bonds. We are in agreement that the bond market is the




