## MAJORITY OF ONLY 31 VOTES INSURES MACDONALD'S RULE

**Crucial Test for Laborites**

(By the Associated Press)

LONDON, Nov. 4.—A majority of only 31 votes carried the Ramsay Macdonald government safely through the first important division of the current parliamentary session late tonight.

This was regarded a crucial test, for the balloting was on a motion by the Conservative party to amend the address from the throne. The amendment was defeated by 201 votes to 169.

The amendment from the throne, delivered by King George at the opening of parliament, but voicing the aims of the Labor party, has been under discussion since the Conservatives' rebellion. It would be virtually impossible for the conservative parties to wrest control of the government of Vienna out of the Socialists' hands, an object long sought for.


