

CANAL DIRECTORS VOTE REDUCTION IN MAINTENANCE LEVEL

Majority of Board Favors
Cut, of 25 Cents On Each
Share; Minority Wants
• Still Heavier Slash

After a prolonged discussion the Twin Falls Canal board voted yesterday to cut the maintenance levy of \$17.50 a share, previously adopted and to levy instead \$14.50 a share for the coming year. The two sides were the result of the resolution was two to one, the affirmative were Mr. V. G. Sherr, Pres.; Mr. Linn, W. H. Hartfield, and Mr. W. G. Brown, Castledore, and the negative were Mr. Hatfield, Mr. J. E. Higgins, and Mr. C. C. Clegg.

The discussion centered around the question of the best method of helping alleviate the depressed condition of farmers on the project. Mr. Hartfield and Mr. Higgins favored a heavy cut, while Mr. Clegg and Mr. Sherr believed it would be advisable to cut the levy to \$12.50 a share, with a view of borrowing money to meet the emergency.

It was finally decided that since the opinion enough economies could be introduced to obviate the necessity of borrowing at all if the levy were cut to \$12.50.

The levy of \$17.50 per acre is the same as the levy made last January. The budget of approximately \$1,000,000 will be reduced by \$250,000 dollars from the 1930 budget. Mr. Hartfield said last night that the board had not yet worked out the complete plan, but that the members of the majority felt confident that it could be done. "The budget has not so far been changed."

The final resolution follows:

"Motion made by Director Clegg and seconded by Director Sharp that the resolution adopted at the meeting of the board of directors of the Twin Falls Canal company on October 14, 1930, fixing the maintenance charge for the ensuing year at \$17.50 per acre, be amended to provide in lieu hereof the following resolution be adopted to-wit: The sum of \$14.50 and due and payable on or prior to January 15, 1931."

Two Nations Plan Discus-
sions Regarding Franco-
Italian Disarmament

PARIS, Dec. 23 (AP)—Franco-Ital-
ian naval conferences will be re-
sumed in Paris on Friday, December 26,
before the opening of the session of the
League of Nations council.

Both France and Italy are desirous
of reaching an agreement which would
provide adherence to the London na-
val treaty. The whole problem is
now being discussed between
two British, Lord Cranfield, who is a
British delegate to the London naval
conference, and the French delegate at Genoa.

naval and colonial problems which to the French are in-

CHRISTMAS IN TWIN FALLS

The things we do and feel at Christmas time are individual reactions, but, perhaps, in the cinema, they reveal something of the true significance of that transcendent event.

Times change, and the manner of observance varies, but the spirit of Christmas continues through the centuries, prompting to love and service and giving.

No event in the calendar exerts an effect so profound and far-reaching as the Christmas season.

Lodging, decorating a Christmas tree and little gifts with candy and nuts and oranges for the children's Christmas party.

Salvation army battles on the streets.

Hundreds of garments and pairs of shoes, gathered together with quantities of pretzel for distribution among needy persons.

Scores of men and women and children giving cheer and comfort to fortitude ones.

In my survey of Christmases observed and activities here basis for opinion, I find that the most come out when step mothers thing is analyzed. Christmas is being made extremely practical; if, indeed, it is not really commercially treated.

The manner of observance is but a measure of individual capacity for understanding and appreciating the event.

Here is an interesting parallel in the life of Bernard Shaw in "The Apple Cart." In that play the King of England, being a smarmy demand from a labor cabinet that he renounce the last royal power, the Queen of rats says he will abdicate. Then comes the Republicans,

on his cabinet, until he explains that he will let his son assume the crown. While he himself forces an election, runs for parliament and becomes prime minister. The politicians know he has the brains and popular strength to do it, and to save their sons they let him alone.

Alfonso, either as prime minister or president, would probably be a "hit."

WISE KIDS

One of the most interesting things we've read about Hollywood is a long time is the fact that only four out of a high school graduating class of more than 200 students chose any sort of movie career for their life-time.
