(By the Associated Press) PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 5.—Benny Bass, junior lightweight champion, defended his title successfully at the arena tonight, knocking out Lew Massey, Philadelphia Italian. Bass weighed 128½ pounds, Massey, 128.

Tonight's bout was fought along the same lines as marked a non-title battle between the Philadelphia boxer and the champion, the challenger keeping his punches in closer quarters. A capacity crowd of 10,000 saw the bout.
