Idaho House Appropriation Bills Require \$492,900 To Operate State Government

Measures Reveal Close Par-
ing, Resulting in Re-
duction of Operation Ex-
penses by Nearly \$5000

(By The Associated Press)

BECAUSE of the liberal appropriation bill came into the house today, carrying slightly less than a half million dollars for state governmental departments but showing a close paring that resulted in a reduction of operating expenses.

On balance, at all decreases, however, was an increase of \$50,000 in the amount asked for forest fire fighting activities—an increase approved by the appropriations committee in its setting part of the deficiency bills which have 144 to 163 not authorizing the legislature for expenses in fighting fires.

The total for all departments included in the bills was \$42,900. Shared of \$50,000 increase for forest fire fighting was the increase of \$478 below the amount appropriated last October for the same departments.

Among these were the governor's office, the attorney general, the administrative staff of the department of public works, the state auditor, the treasurer, the finance department, the state controller, the land department, forest department and general.

House Passes Memorial

The "House" passed a memorial asking the committee on national defense to allow one of the new soldiers to be sent to the front. It received a resolution from Representatives Valley, County and Stewart, Boundary county, urging the committee to establish a similar unit at Lava Hot Springs for veterans.

The resolution urged that the house appropriate \$10,000 to be adjusted to such an institution, appropriate for which had been made by Congress.

Although opposition developed to the proposal, it was voted down.

A House committee on transportation has passed a resolution calling for a federal-state study of the Idaho highway system.

After considerable discussion the highway survey went on road instead of survey. Representative White, Shoshone county, Republic committee said if the survey discovered even one place where a relocation would be an improvement it would probably affect the route which the survey covered in Idaho.

And on Pension Bill

(By THE Associated Press) NEW YORK, Jan. 27.— Max Schmeling, German boxer, holder of the world's heavyweight championship, arrived in New York aboard the "Europa" to-night, in first rate condition and confident that he will whip W. L. (Young) Stribling when they clash in June.

His first words carried a denial that he had made any derogatory either to the New York state athletic commission or to the German boxing commission. He added that he was a member of the commission under which he is to meet Stribling in June and possibly Prime Carew of Italy in July.

"My job is to fight," said Max seriously. "I am here to manage. Whatever is done is right with me."

Schmeling was a member of the delegation that took a double-header to-night in two hard-fought contests. The local girls won the first, while the boys won the second, dropping the second of three events to Coach O'Donnell's team by a 21-11 count.
