Idaho House Passes State Car Branding Measure and Hears Rupert Man's Advice

Few Solons Object to Marking Governor's Machine, Fearing Increased Risk of Chief's Assassination

(By The Associated Press) **OCT. 19.—**The house of the state legislature has passed almost unanimously a bill providing for a prominent marking of all state cars to show them to be the property of the state of Idaho.

The car branding bill was passed with only two dissenting votes and sent along to the senate. It provides for a prominent marking in two-inch letters. The governor's car will be especially marked by the state seal.

Opposition to the bill drew a running fire of comment which reached all the way from references to the "idiot's" to a state car by John Doe, to a statement by Representative Lowell, Payette county, that the car might make him a target for assassins.

Refusing to accept an adverse report of the reference committee that had been made, Chairman Davis of the education committee, moved that the bill be referred to the committee on education and appointed to it the merits of the bill.

The debate finally drew in others and brought a resolution from Representative Fred Hansen, Malheur county, chairman of the Republican house caucus, that it is time to force double debate on bills.

"It is too late in the session to have to debate every bill two times, both on printing and on passage," he said. "The bill is so simple that it should be ordered printed. One would place common and just schools districts under one roof, and give the board of education authority to regulate examinations, a duty now given to the state board of education which who does not do."

Newspapermen said the "idiot's" contained an amendment to hold the twenty-first amendment to the state constitution until a tax relief bill was enacted.
