GIRL RECOVERS FROM FRACTURE OF SKULL

Mrs. June Dewhurst, Jerome, 16-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A. L. Dewhurst, Jerome, Idaho, was admitted to the county general hospital from the effects of a fractured skull sustained about 10 days ago in a fall from a horse.

Authorities here said that to get rid of him, Will Aron Kerr, 20, of Twin Falls, a laundry worker, Manning attempted a jail break within a week after being assigned to a cell in the county jail. He threatened suicide, and 102 other prisoners he would seek an opportunity to attack the jailor, jailer, or sheriff if which he was a disturbing element in the institution.

Bears Criminal Record

Investigation made by local authorities indicated that Manning violated the law in the Washington state prison at Walla Walla when he was sentenced to a two-year-term for burglarizing a laundry. He had been held for investigation at Rupert early last February after he had threatened to do so again.

Dewhurst said that here indicated that he waited for the Kimberly man at his garage door and forced him at the point of a gun to give him \$100 and \$150 in money together with a number of checks. Then, the evidence showed, he forced the victim to drive to his home in Twin Falls, and that on the way Manning occupied the rear seat and lighted matches to furnish light while he sorted the money from the pockets and checked in the car seat.

Manning was arrested by police officers in Twin Falls in connection with the robbery, when his behavior at the robbery, when his behavior at a restaurant and later at a barber shop aroused suspicion. He fled to Idaho, and was captured in a car in a catch of approximately 400 miles under the carpet. He had about \$50 in his pocket.

Manning did not take the witness stand during the trial, nor was any evidence introduced in his behalf, but he was identified by state's witness of Manning as the robber.
