FLASHES from LIFE

STIMSON DEPARTS FOR CONFERENCE IN BERLIN

LONDON, July 24 (AP)—Secretary of State Henry L. Stimson was on the way to Germany tonight where for two days he will continue his conversations with German officials. His departure for Berlin was announced by the British Foreign Office.

This visit is just a trip to one more European capital to become better acquainted with the heads of the several governments.

It is nothing to do with financial matters, he said, and is not connected with the case of the seven-power conference which just ended.

In authoritative quarters it was said the Germans had abandoned their intention to present to Mr. Stimson their plans for a large American credit. It is understood the request never was made, and it is a general feeling that such a matter is a problem for the bankers rather than for the statesmen.

On Tuesday he will be back, to remain in London until he goes on to Scotland for the grouse shooting.

Fire Ends Lives Of 30 Aged Inmates In Home at Pittsburgh

Score of Persons Appears on List of Missing, And 100 Receive Treatment at Hospitals As Result of Fierce Blaze in Catholic Institution For Feeble, Crippled and Old

PITTSBURGH, (Saturday Morning), July 25—Thirty persons were known to be dead early this morning, 20 were missing, and more than 100 were in hospitals after a fire had destroyed the home for the aged of the Little Sisters of the Poor here.

Most of the dead were aged inmates of the home, located at the corner of South Aiken and Penn avenues in the East End district. Efforts to make a check on the number which might have been trapped in the home, which housed numerous cripples, were futile because the rescued were at various hospitals and in a nearby school and private homes.
