OGDEN, Utah, Oct. 16 (AP)—A 10-year-old daughter of Mrs. J. T. O'Brien, fell 300 feet from a peak in Ogden canyon and was instantly killed late today.

The tragedy was witnessed by three of the five companions who had accompanied the girl on a hiking trip. Mrs. and Mr. A. Montgomery and Miss Edna Shaw, Liberty, who were with the girl, saw her fall. Her body struck the head of the O'Brien river, 100 feet below where she had started to the top of the peak when the girl slipped and fell.

Such a step would only irritate the sensitive feelings of the Japanese people, who are particularly susceptible regarding Manchuria."
