



# COMMERCIAL BODY REPORT INDICATES EXTENSIVE ACTIVITY

Chamber of Commerce Secretary Shows Many Results From Year of Persistent Community Labor

Appreciation of the multitude of activities in which an active chamber of commerce will participate in the course of a year can be gathered from a perusal of the annual report of H. W. Wright, secretary of the Twin Falls Chamber of Commerce, covering the period from December 1, 1930, until November 30, 1931, inclusive.

The report shows that the Twin Falls commercial organization has participated in many matters of general interest such as highway construction, better road connections and more complete understanding between city and country. At the same time, matters of particular interest to the southern Idahoans have been brought to the attention of the report.

In the matter of better railroad service and tariffing the report points out the various occasions on which the chamber took steps to secure data on costs of the Oregon-Wyoming line as a basis for maintaining tariff reductions; and to its steady opposition to the proposed increase of 15 per cent in rates at one time asked by the roads. The movement for lower rates asked succeeded to the satisfaction of the chamber.

In other matters the report shows a cooperative spirit on the part of Twin Falls toward surrounding cities, towns and sections. Persistent work was done toward highway improvement, especially toward construction of United States highway number 93 from Banfill to Shoshone. The Twin Falls municipal band was sent by the organization to Shoshone to assist in the Idaho celebration. Various other bodies were invited to hold conventions here. The chamber of commerce directors sent the secretary of the organization to Palo Alto to attend the western division of schools for secretaries of chambers of commerce, and to make personal contact with people from other states in order to bring them to this section to become familiar with its agricultural and other advantages.

In order to reach better understanding with farmers a representative of the Grange is elected to the board of directors as an honorary member and an annual home product supper meeting is held with heads of all farm Granges as guests. Special endorsement was given the Twin Falls Future Farmers county fair, 4-H club activities, national wool week programs, and other farm movements.

A list of proposed activities largely intended to benefit agriculture has been proposed to the membership. Purely municipal matters are also given a prominent place. Movement for bringing in new industries like canneries beneficial to workers, farmers and city residents are kept in view, it is indicated in the report.

This is an amendment to China and Japan to cooperate in suppressing banditry. The Japanese position is that the Briand statement does not give Japan enough latitude in dealing with bandits.

**DELAYS SETTLEMENT**  
PARIS, Dec. 3 (AP)—Prospects for early settlement of the Sino-Japanese conflict receded further into the distance tonight when it was learned that Japan was steadfastly objecting to two features of the League of Nations proposal for an international commission of inquiry.  
Tokyo's note had not been officially communicated to League authorities but the Japanese delegation let it be known that Japan cannot accept one provision of the element resolution and one stipulation of the declaration by Aristide Briand, council chairman, which will accompany it.

The commission of inquiry, Tokyo insists, should not be empowered to report to the League council any alleged failure of the Japanese forces in Manchuria to withdraw as quickly as the commission believes warranted. This is one of the provisions of the resolution.  
The draft of M. Briand's declaration stipulates that the Japanese may voluntarily take measures against bandits only in exceptional circumstances and that any such provision, expedition should be accompanied by neutral observers.  
The Japanese government is unwilling to allow neutrals to accom-

pany their troops operating against bandits.  
Pending official receipt of the Japanese note the council did not meet today and did not schedule a meeting for tomorrow.

## NEW MICROSCOPE INSURES PROGRESS

Two Scientists Open Way to First Slight of Organisms Producing 60 Diseases

**PASADENA, Cal., Dec. 3 (AP)**—Combined efforts of two scientists have made it possible for the first time to see with a new and powerful microscope bacteria which cause some 60 communicable diseases.

Their work is hailed as promising to lay the basis for revolutionary discoveries in bacteriology.

One of the men, Royal Raymond Rife, left college 14 years ago with a desire to experiment and invent. In order to find time for his experiments he obtained work as a chauffeur and fitted out a laboratory on the second floor of a Pasadena house.

The other scientist, Dr. Arthur Isaac Kendall, director of medical research at Northwestern university, discovered what he termed "Medium K," a substance in which it was possible to cultivate germs as they develop in the human body.

In his effort to filter and isolate certain germs notably typhoid, he found they at first appeared in "rod" shape. On further filtration they disappeared. He believed they formed a smaller form, "no microscope" available was powerful enough to confirm his belief.

High-Powered Dr. Milbank Johnson, prominent physician and civic leader of Pasadena, and a friend of Dr. Kendall, knew of his experiments and

learned Dr. Rife had perfected a microscope which magnified from 5000 to 17,000 diameters. This great enlargement giving good detail under other available microscopes was about 1500 diameters.

Dr. Kendall and Dr. Rife were brought together by Dr. Johnson's home here. In experiments performed by them Dr. Kendall was able to follow the typhoid bacteria through numerous filtrations with the new microscope, and confirmed his belief that they changed form in the filtrable state.

Numbers of contagious diseases are believed to be caused by "filterable" bacteria which have not yet been cultivated and had not been seen under microscopes heretofore available. Dr. Kendall said these diseases include infantile paralysis, measles, smallpox, influenza and common cold. They have been produced experimentally in animals with infected material but the microbes themselves have been invisible.
