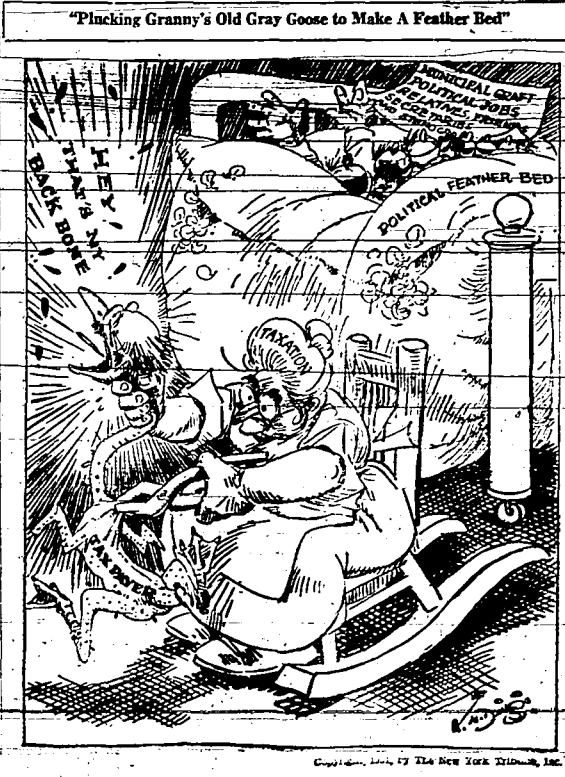

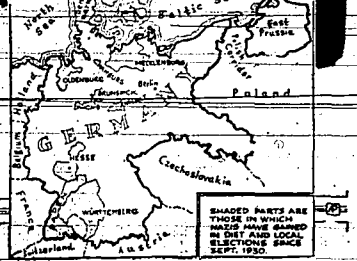

FUTURE HOLDS FATE OF NAZI PARTY IN TEUTONIC POLITICS

Leader of National Socialists Records Steady Gains Since Ballot
NEW FACTION FAILS TO DOMINATE GOVERNMENT
Other Elements Dispute Victory of Hitlerites But Chief Makes Big Claims

BERLIN, Jan. 27 (Special to the News)—The wind is blowing strong in the land as the time approaches when National Socialism seems destined to gain its first big point, a place in the cabinet of the reich, by the recent summoning of Adolf Hitler to the capital to confer with Chancellor Bruening and Wilhelm Ganner, secretary of the government, as well as the other members of the cabinet. The political situation is so tense that the development of the situation is being watched with keen interest by the public.

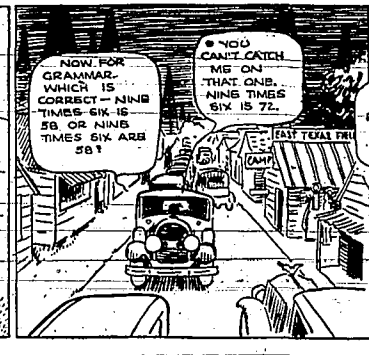
