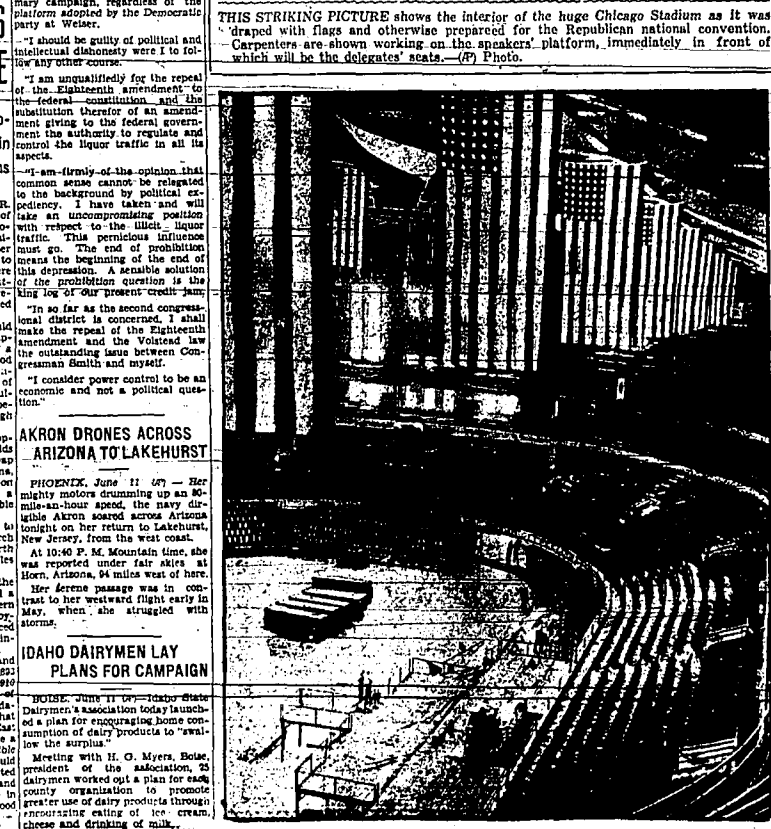

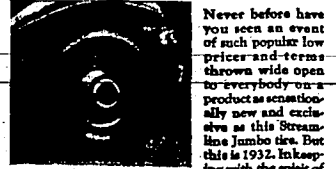

By CHARLES DUNKLEY (Associated Press Sports Writer) CHICAGO, June 11.—Ralph Metcalfe, 23-year-old Negro youth from Marquette university, who today, in two amazing races, broke the world records of the century.

Metcalfe, in the most sensational individual performance in track history, entered the world marks for the 220-yard dash, the 100 meters, the 200 meters and tied the world record for the 100 meters for the century.

Metcalfe was the outstanding performer, although not much ahead of George Goring, white star from Ohio State, who today, in two amazing races, broke the world records of the century.

Metcalfe, a powerfully built youngster weighing 165 pounds, standing 5 feet 11 inches, started his amazing achievement by winning the 100-yard dash in 13.3 seconds, breaking the world record of 13.8 seconds.

Metcalfe's most sparkling race was the 200-yard dash in which he started a half of a second from the world mark, to beat another Negro, George Goring, who broke the world record of 26.2 seconds.
