(By the Associated Press) NEW YORK, Jan. 4.—College football is not on the decline merely because it is one of the victims of the business depression, the president's committee on education today said. "Public interest may eventually shift from college to professional football because of the latter's greater financial appeal," it writes.

"If this should happen," writes Dr. F. H. Brown, professor of psychology at the University of Washington, who contributed the chapter on sports and the national committee report, "public interest may follow college football's lead and be attracted to a game of no more than local interest."

"Grave ill effects have resulted from the stress and struggle to win championships," Dr. Brown's report says. "The student athlete is being tempted to reorganize his activities more in accord with professional sports."

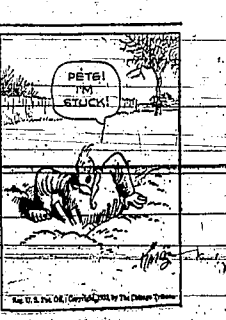

Frank E. Haasch Discusses Railway Exports and Imports at Rotary Session

Freight shipments declined in Twin Falls last year because only about 8 per cent under incoming freight shipments. Frank E. Haasch, president of the Twin Falls Rotary club, discussed the situation at a luncheon meeting at the club last night.

Mr. Haasch quoted comparative figures showing that Twin Falls freight receipts totaled 5390 carloads last year, as compared with 5286 carloads in 1929, and that freight shipments for 1932 from Twin Falls amounted to 5262 carloads last year.

Estimated value of 2652 carloads of freight of all kinds forwarded from the Twin Falls district in 1932 was \$1,420,000, as compared with \$1,370,000 for 1931. The detailed figures on outgoing freight shipments for 1932 compared with 1931 are as follows:
