Idaho's Most Severe Storm In Years Halts All Kinds Of Traffic

CREW TAKES OVER SHIP AFTER MUTINY... State Highway Department Reports Inability of Crews to Clear Roads As Fast As Snow Drifts

(By The Associated Press) OREGON, Feb. 6.—Traffic of all kinds was virtually paralyzed in southern Idaho tonight, following a 24-hour blizzard said by old residents to have been one of the worst in years.

While there was little evidence of the widespread storm in the immediate vicinity of Boise, reports from all other sections of southern Idaho indicated it would be 24 hours more before travel by highway would be possible.

State highway department reports that the snow drifts on the main highways were unable to be cleared as fast as they were being piled up.

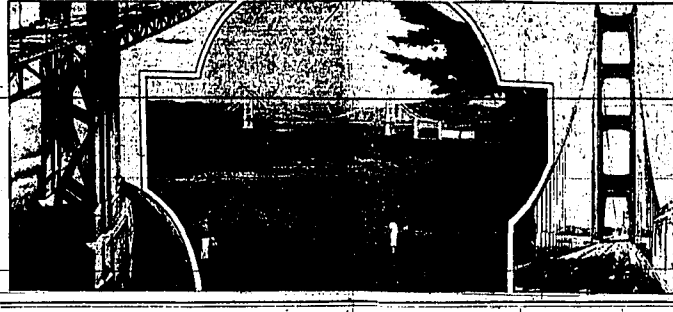


