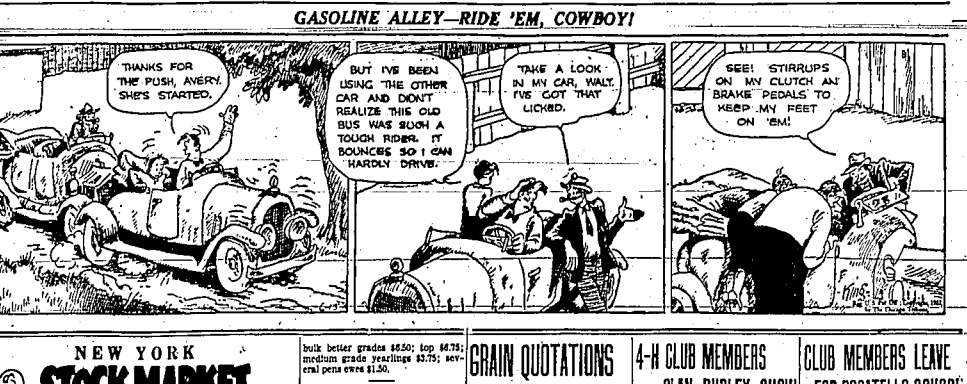

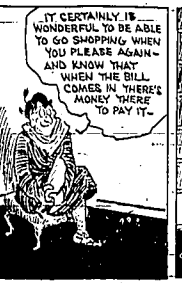

COUNCIL REFUSES ORDINANCE TO FIX BUSINESS HOURS

Vote Follows Attorney's Advice Proposed Regulation Would Be "Unwarranted Interference with Rights"

Twelve merchants and employes were submitted to the council last week, requesting regulations and ordinances regarding business hours, Monday and Tuesday, and designated holidays and on 19 and 20, M. Saturday and 6 P. M. other day.

When the city council turned down a petition for fixing business hours for Twin Falls business houses, after George M. Paulson, city attorney, advised that the ordinance would be an unwarranted governmental interference with individual freedom of the merchant class of the citizens of the town.

Members of Twin Falls city council, including two councilmen who two years ago approved a daily ordinance that prohibited sale of milk from cows afflicted with Bangs disease, unless that milk were pasteurized, here this morning.

Mrs. Rogerson, a trained nurse of more than 20 years experience, argued that recent investigations show that most fresh cows carrying the Bangs disease only 800 cases in the entire United States and that if the disease were actually a divergent as some persons believe, the burden of combating it should be borne by the dairy industry alone and not by the dairy industry alone.
