WEATHER SLACKENS HARVEST OF BEETS

Growers and Processors Delicids on Delay to Cash Tonnage and Sugar Content

"Twin Falls district sugar beet growers and processors have decided it will be their mutual advantage to delay the sugar beet harvest on account of weather conditions," according to a statement given out following a conference yesterday between officials of the Beet Growers' association and the Annapolis Sugar company.

"Because of continuing warm weather, it was expected that the yield of beets would be still increasing in tonnage and sugar content."

"Here is the statement given out following yesterday's conference:

"At a meeting of the local Beet Growers' Association and the Annapolis Sugar company, held at the home of Mrs. J. E. White, it was decided that the beets are carrying a low sugar content, and it was decided that the best interests of the beet growers and the sugar company that steps be taken to slow up delivery of beets."

"It was pointed out that the weather is too warm for piling, and that delivery in this weather will result in a loss of sugar content."

"Cooperation in the above matters will materially assist in the harvest of the 1933 crop in such way as will be to the best advantage of everyone concerned."

CALICO SEES BIAS FACTOR IN VERDICT

Hansen Man Convicted of Manslaughter in Collision Mishap, Seeks New Trial

Otto Calico, 34, Hansen, under sentence of a 10-year imprisonment for manslaughter in connection with the fatal injury to Mrs. Rosemary Kimberly last August 13, applied to the district court here yesterday for a new trial, claiming he was prejudiced by a juror "who in the district court here returned September 25."

In support of the motion for a new trial, Calico's attorney, Chapman and Chapman, argue that the verdict in the case of manslaughter was reached by an automobile collision near the site of the fatal accident, and testimony of four girls who were her companions at the time of the accident, and the fact that a great number of automobile accidents, fatal and otherwise, have occurred during the past few weeks in this vicinity.

Davis and his partner-in-law, J. C. Davis, from March 1 to July 19, 1932, Mr. Vineyard testified the district court here yesterday.

His testimony was given in trial of a suit that he and Davis are prosecuting against the Fletcher Oil company and Idaho-Fidelity corporation for alleged damages on account of alleged ejection from the service station on July 19, 1932, in asserted violation of terms of a one-year lease agreement entered into by Davis and his partner-in-law, J. C. Davis, on September 1, 1932, and which was re-captured at Phoenix, Arizona, last November 2, by William Twin Falls county prosecuting attorney, who was sentenced to serve a life term in prison at Hard labor for the first time in the history of the state of Idaho.

Mr. Vineyard testified yesterday, a gas station "was being waged in Twin Falls so that patrons of the Piner station would purchase only the gas of the Fletcher Oil company and save a dollar on it."

"During that period," he said, "he paid the gas a gallon that he sold for 25 cents a gallon, and the same gasoline was being sold in Twin Falls for 19 cents a gallon."

"Unpaid and Davis secured a restraining order and accessories arrested in connection with the service station."

"The bill of damages against the Fletcher company includes \$1500 for loss on forced sale of property for the asserted ejection; \$2573.75 for loss of profit; and the remainder of the lease term, and \$5000 punitive damages."

"Filed in this action, the first on the court's civil calendar for the year, began with selection of a jury early yesterday afternoon."

Mr. Vineyard, the first witness, was "interrogated on cross-examination when District Judge W. H. Babcock called the evening session."

"Turner K. Hickman, Twin Falls is presenting the case for Vineyard and Davis; Fletcher Oil company being represented by Messrs. Z. Stephen and J. H. Shandford, Twin Falls attorneys."

PROSECUTOR FIGHTS PARDON FOR THARP

All Members of Jury That Convicted Slayer of Woman Join in Protest

Armed with a petition of protest that was placed in circulation here yesterday, J. William Twin Falls county prosecuting attorney, will appear before the state parole board today to resist claims for pardon for Ward Otis Tharp, who was convicted here of murder of Mrs. Lois May Down, a neighbor, in September, 1928, and who was re-captured at Phoenix, Arizona, last November 2, by William Twin Falls county prosecuting attorney, who was sentenced to serve a life term in prison at Hard labor for the first time in the history of the state of Idaho.

"Among the first signers of the petition of protest against pardon for Tharp are all three members of the board of Twin Falls county commissioners."

In addition to this petition, the board, letters written by every member of the jury that found Tharp guilty, all protesting against granting of pardon."

Mr. William prosecuted Tharp at trial in the district court here in November, 1928.

Tharp, then 31 years old, was found guilty of shooting Mrs. Down, mother of three little girls, as she stood in her own doorway, following a quarrel of neighborhood quarrel.
