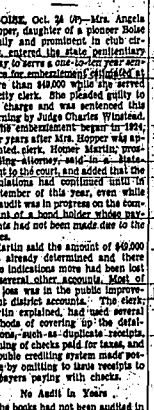

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# Michigan "Wolves" In Line For Fifteenth Championship

## Kipke's Gridsters Logical Choice of Football Experts

Selecting Winner Next Best Thing to Clinch, Writer Believes; Conference Record Shows .765 Average

CHICAGO, Oct. 24.—Football experts here predicted today that the Michigan "Wolves" are the logical choice of the Big Ten championship.

The rest of the Big Ten teams have not done what the Wolverines have done. Over 25 years of competition in the conference, the "Wolves" have produced six national champions in football. Exclusive of this year, they have emerged with 10 victories, 26 defeats, and only one tie, one of the most remarkable records in college gridiron lore.

Another reason for the selection of Michigan is the fact that the Wolverines have won the Big Ten championship in 1929, 1930 and 1931, and tied for the championship last year. They have won 297 points in 122 games, an average of 2.45 points a game.

In other sports, notably track and basketball, the "Wolves" have been the champions of the Big Ten conference in those sports cannot compare with their football reputation.

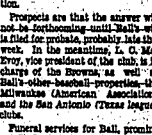

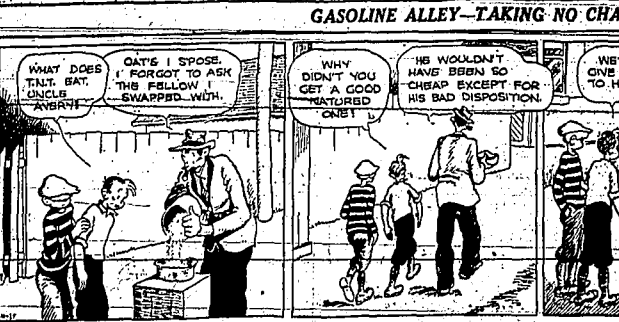

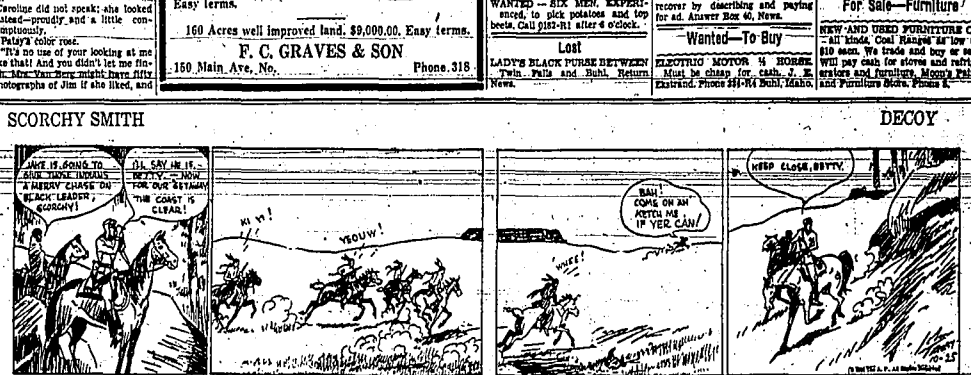
