This morning, finding John Goertzen, Hansan arctic station operator, not guilty of kidnaping P. J. Pringle in connection with the oil and feather abduction of P. J. Pringle, Twin Falls mortgage holder, last January 25.

The jury heard the case at 9:30 p. m., yesterday, and was instructed to remain until a verdict had been reached. The trial occupied a week and two days.

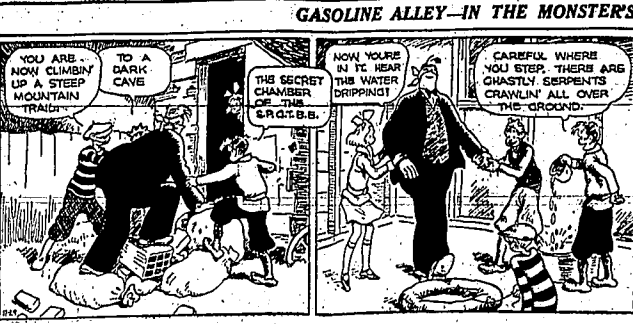

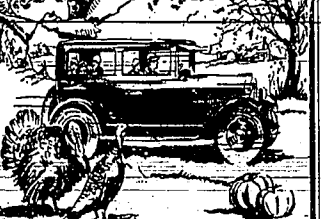
