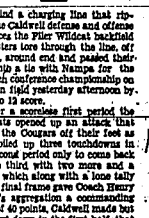

NEW YORK, Dec. 1—In a terrific battle of ballots and ballots, for the fifth successive year, the balance of All-America power in college football ranks has been captured by the middle-west.



Gridiron products of the great American midlands captured four of the eleven positions in the all-star lineup named by the nation's experts in the ninth annual Association of Three continents selection.

Three positions on the big team go to the Far West. Two to the South, although they produced the only major undefeated and undefeated in 1933, but are afflicted with two pieces each.

The Mid-West can thank the relatively all-around strength of the Big Ten and its neighbors, combined in the Big Six, for the distinction of leading the "Grid" Press argument under control in a season decided by the sharp and starting details of Notre Dame's year and the first in five successive campaigns that the Fighting Irish have not conducted since a very early date to the all-star eleven. Their only consolation is the naming of Thayer Devore at end of the team.

In the Big Ten, the early season ballroom was strong for Crayton of Iowa and Zercher of Michigan, high scorer of the conference, but finished with the best performance, Ohio State's back, with the exception of Crayton's performance. "Feather" Roberts were disappointed. So were the Notre Dame ball-carrier, Ed McCullough, and the Purdue star, Franklyn of Oregon State, Mike Mikulak of Oregon and "Tebow" Wilson of St. Mary's.
