LOUISIANA ELECTION DISPUTE MARKED BY EXCHANGE OF SHOTS

Latest Outbreak Adds to Fears of Bloodshed; 25 Armed Men Seek to Halt Delivery of Ballots

By The Associated Press. BATON ROUGE, La., Dec. 4.—A group of 25 armed citizens and a company of truck, believed by the state to be the militia, were seen to be exchanging shots with the truck on the bridge and entered into a running race and averted the calling of an election in the Sixth district without holding a Democratic primary.

Fears of Bloodshed. No one was injured in the exchange of some 20 shots, but the shooting added to the grave fears of a possible bloodbath.

At the truck passed, the citizens fired a volley and the fire was returned inside the truck. Windows of the truck were shattered but the men lost to a narrow

# SILVER PURCHASES IN VIEW SAYS POPE

Senator Predicts New High For Gold, Federal Backing of White Metal Price

WASHINGTON, Dec. 4 (AP).—Senator Pope, Democrat, Indiana, Saturday predicted the federal government in an effort to aid the silver industry would purchase quantities of the white metal within the next few weeks.

Anticipating a price of \$125 an ounce for gold, which would be double the present—silver—before Congress convenes January 4, Pope said such a bond would be one of the administration's moves to forestall the expected tremendous pressure for currency inflation in Congress.

Pope predicted that immediately gold reaches the \$125 price, the government would turn to the purchase of silver "until it could buy the silver mining industry with a fair profit."

Senator Pope said both Senator Wheeler, Democrat, Montana, and Senator Dill, Democrat, Washington, had quoted President Roosevelt as favoring the purchase of silver for industry stabilization and stimulation.

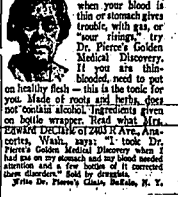

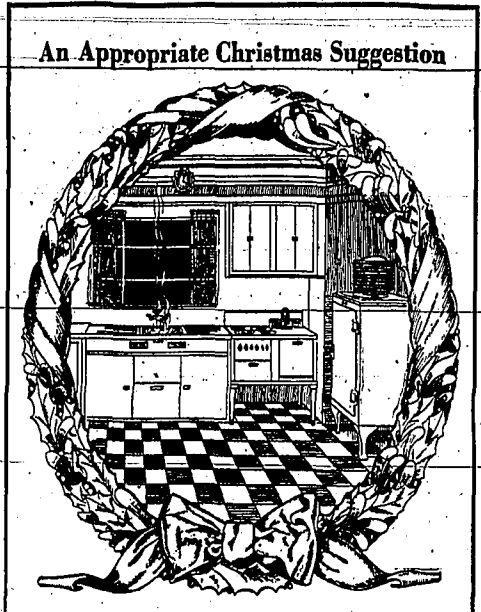
