Verdict Forecast Says Four Men Go Free, and One To Block

BERLIN, Dec. 21 (AP)—A sentence of death for the four accused of firing the German parliament last night was pronounced by the court today. The other defendants will be confined in the verdict of a separate court session before which the trial has been tried, the Associated Press learned today from a usually reliable source.

The informant said Martin Van Der Lubbe, a young Dutch bricklayer, was sentenced to death, that Ernst Thälmer, a former communist, was sentenced to life imprisonment, and that the Bulgarians, Georg Dimitroff, Bogdan Bogdanoff and Wassil Taneff, were sentenced to life imprisonment from Germany.
