(Continued From Page One) grand jury today the law requires that the accused must face trial by jury. The only penalty provided, however, in case of conviction, is removal from office. The defendant has the usual right of appeal.

The second was against John J. Hamilton, then chairman of the board of supervisors.

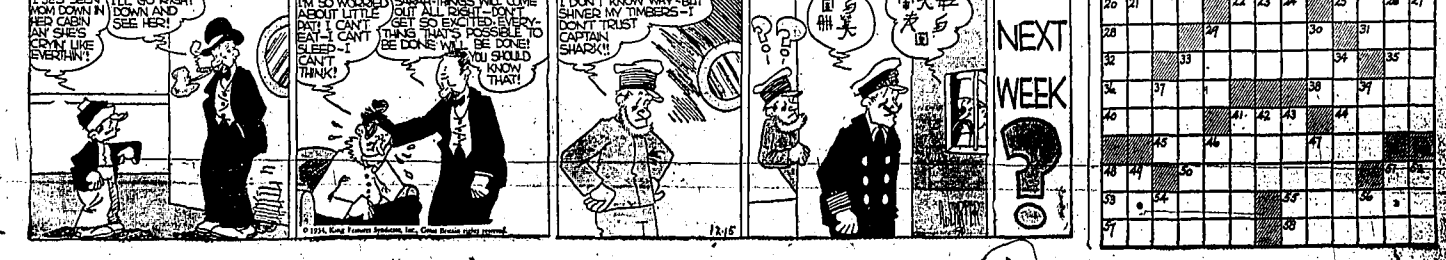
