Invited by a group of his constituents to give his reasons for opposing the use of one cent of the gasoline tax to raise funds for relief purposes in Idaho, Senator Peters of Jerome County declares that in his judgment such a step would not be in the best in terests of either Jerome County or the State of Idaho

Senator Peters' views are interesting for the reason that they are so exactly typical of what seems to be the general viewpoint on the subject. Fresh taxation is better than economy. When more money is needed don't try to supply it from some existing source but assess more taxes, or sell bonds, or bor-row it or something, but under no circumstances try to raise it by spending less money on something else.

The sincerity of Senator Peters is not in

question but the wisdom of any policy which would add constantly to State operating ex-penses to meet current demands is. Perhaps the day will come when lawmakers and others charged with keeping the finances of Idaho upon something approaching an even keel will be willing to consider a different policy but there isn't much indication of it


