#### WHOSE WATER?

Residents of Eastern Idaho feel that the construction of another dam on the South fork of the Snake river will solve their water roubles. But storage reservoirs do not create water out of nothingness; they can only conserve and store flood waters for use as. The flood waters of the Snake have been fully taken care of for a long time, ever since the construction of the American Falls. dam. The sight of a volume of water flow-ing over Shoshone Falls is only a distant

With what do upper valley residents plan to fill their reservoir? Will they wait until tother reservoirs, including American Falls, Jacquir-reservoirs, including American Fails, are full?-In-that case-they-will-have a long, long wait. Or do they intend to appropriate the river for their own use until some desperate farmer from Twin Fails, Jerome, or Gooding goes East with a truckload of diversities.

There have already been too many irrigation projects instituted without due regard for prior water rights, as witness the strice over the waters of the Teton river and the Big Lost river. Let's not have any more.

#### OCEAN GATEWAYS

The question arises—whether one nation you polish it up-has a right—divine, legal or moral—to con-trol a great international scaway. The Sucz HUEY Canal is the ocean gate-from Europe to the East. It controls the most direct route from western Europe and the Mediterranean area to India, China, Japan and the East Indies, and vice versa, as well as the route from Burope to East Africa. One little set of locks might determine the fortunes of half a world commercially and militarily.

Great Britain holds the key. The Sucz Canal is technically not a public decern but a private business concern. Nevertheless, all

It has to be so, according to the British view, for it is the chief material link that binds the British Empire together, Without it Britain's hiold on India would be precarious, and Australia; and many a lesser possession or dependency would be far away and hard, to defend.
