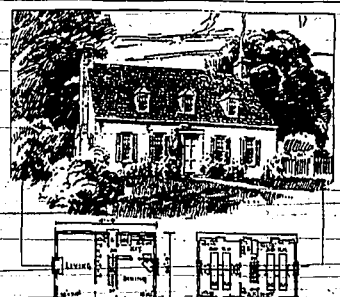

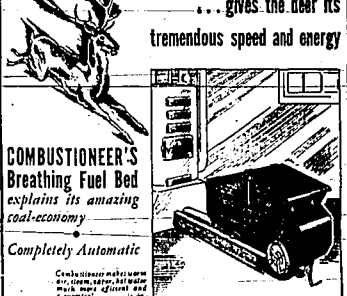

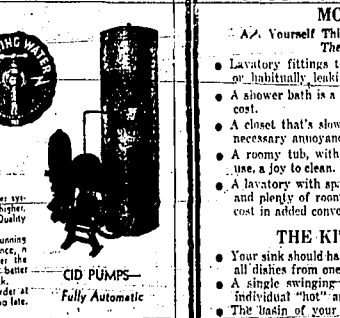

The relief bank which has advanced the carry over will be so heavy it will be impossible for them to go along for the next year's crop. Dealers are in same position. We are inquiring if it is possible to find money for relief in the way of purchase of surplus apples damaged but usable. Some apples on trees were picked, but still in field. It is represented to us that if immediate financial aid is not had it will work permanent injury to the industry by reason of the number of orchards who will be unable to carry on.

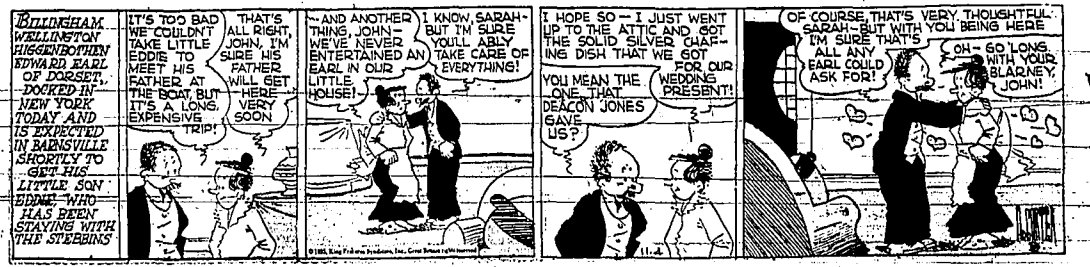

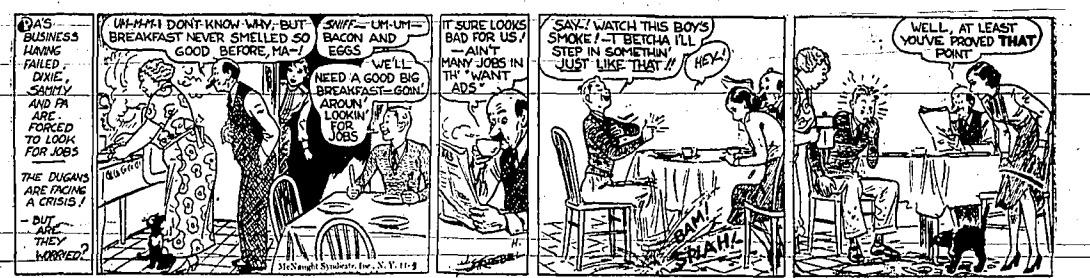

COUNTY REBUFFED IN HOSPITAL CASE

Supreme Court Again Fixes Liability for Damages to Pay Patient

BOISE, Nov. 2 (AP)—In an opinion written by Justice James P. Athlete the Idaho supreme court today affirmed its previous reversal of a judgment of the seventh district court and held again that Twin Falls county is liable for damages to patients in the county general hospital. The opinion was rendered in an action brought by Marie Henderson to collect \$25,000 damages from Twin Falls county for injuries allegedly received while she was under treatment at the county general hospital.

W. Or. Chapman and Marshall Chapman, attorneys for Marie Henderson, appealed originally from the district court judgment which sustained the decision of the Twin Falls county commissioners in the dismissal of her claim.

In the original opinion, written by Justice M. Holden, Marie Henderson's appeal was granted. Today's opinion was an argument made at the rehearing before the Pacific state of the Idaho supreme court. There is no such thing as harmony among the wealth of judicial decisions on the specific question here presented, Justice Athlete wrote.

"We are persuaded, however, that we reached the just and fair solution of the question upon the original trial and that it is our duty to adhere to the conclusion there announced," he continued before observing:

"The decision of this case rests upon the distinction between the discharge of governmental duties and the performance of proprietary or business engagements.

"It is the duty of the county to take care of the indigent and other dependent poor," but it was not bound to build a county hospital—the legislature did not so command.

"In serving such non-dependent and indigent persons, however, it was engaged in the discharge of its public and governmental duty, but was rather engaging to that extent private and proprietary business for pay, and at once assumed the same relation to such persons other than indigent or dependent as would any privately owned hospital sustain toward a patient—entering it for hospital care."

Justice William M. Morgan and Justice Holden concurred. Justice Athlete dissented and Chief Justice Raymond L. Citron concurred "in the conclusion reached."

The county was represented at the rehearing by J. W. Porter, Harry Porey, Edwin Babcock and J. R. Borchert, Twin Falls lawyers.
