## Sacramento Convention Cheers Land Bank Commissioner's Frank Discussion Of Federal Agency

(By The Associated Press) SACRAMENTO, Calif., Nov. 14.—A major weakness of the federal farm loan system which would permit it to be turned into politics overnight was pointed out tonight to the convention of the national Grange by Albert S. Goss, federal land bank commissioner.

The frank discussion of the commissioner, who said his chief complaint was that the federal farm loan system is being used for political purposes, brought a firm response in the crowded convention chambers.

Goss, covering a broad range of subjects relating to rural credit, told the convention that the "biggest problem is returning the farm credit system to the ownership and control of the farmer."

"The control of the federal farm loan system is such," Goss said, "that it can be turned into politics overnight," said the commissioner. "It has not been abused, but there is a grave danger that it will be."

He paid a tribute to the determination of President Roosevelt to see that the politics and credit do not mix.

"I'm not saying to you that so long as the power of appointment of commissioners is in the hands of the governor of the farm credit administration, control of it can be turned into politics overnight, and the future of the system will remain in danger until that weakness is removed," Goss said.

## Law Declared Constitutional In United States Court at Louisville; 19 Companies to Appeal Ruling

(Copyright, 1935, Associated Press) LOUISVILLE, Ky., Nov. 14.—Federal Judge Elwood Hamilton tonight held the Guffey coal act constitutional. He declared that congress has power to regulate wages and prices of any industry through an intervention conference and pronounced the courts powerless to review such a conclusion, if any facts support it.

Federal authority under the constitution's interstate commerce and general welfare clauses, as explained by Judge Hamilton, would sustain legislation which sets a price ceiling, to review such a conclusion, if any facts support it.

"The people of the states intended to surrender all the rights they had to provide the general welfare that could not be done by the states acting independently," he said.



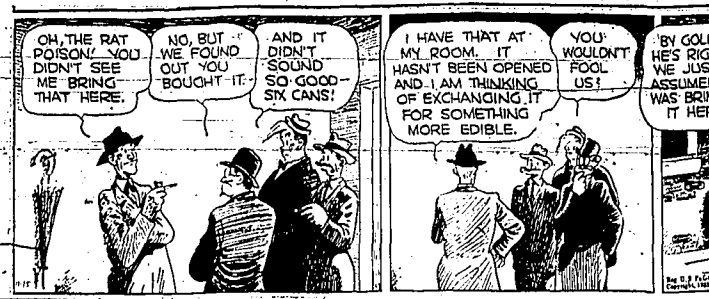

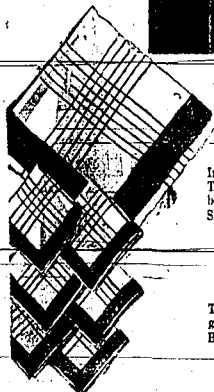
