



## STOCK SPECULATION

The bull movement in stocks has got many people worrying again. For a long time they were afraid securities would never recover. Now they fear securities will rise too far or too fast.

There do seem to be the makings of a big speculative boom corresponding to that 1927-29, Industry is recovering rapidly. Agriculture is regaining buying power. There is a vast deficit of consumers goods in this country and industry and agriculture in the country and meastry and agreeture need billions of dollars', worth of new equipment. Then there is the heavy public outlay for relief projects. And over the whole there is a nort of rainbow arch, both promising and threatening; in the form of the huge gold movement, to this country. This is what

seems to worry cautious observers now.

Nearly, two billion five hundred million dollars of gold has poured into this country, and been sequestered by the government, in two years. In the last twelve months the gain has been about one billion seven hundred fifty million dollars. The total accumulation now is about ten billions, at least half the gold in the world and about three times as much as we used to consider ample. And still Europe is drained further to give us an unnecessary and undesired excess. This movement is appreciated as an expression of confidence, but stimulates speculation.

The Federal Reserve Banks now have more than three billion dollars above legal requirements. There is said to be gold enough to provide, under the existing rules, fifty billion to one hundred billion dollars of new hank credit. The runaway possibilities of stocks, also commodifies and real estate, are

Fortunately there is a reassuring factor. The federal Treasury and the Federal Reserve Board have new credit controls. Wise he hadded, and supplemented by a more con-servative policy of government expenditure, it should be possible to keep the markets ithin reasonable bounds.
