### AGRICULTURE'S DESTINY

It is rather difficult to gain a concrete idea of just what was in the mind of Secretary of Agriculture Wallace when he prepared that portion of his annual report which has to do with the future of American agriculture.

Apparently he favors the lowering of tariff barriers on imports of foodstuffs, which can mean only a gradually diminishing rate of return on American farm products, but at the same time agriculture is to become graci-ually better off notwithstanding the fact that wheat will probably command a lower price in the future than it now has. Here is one point which can be grasped: "Agriculture will not monopolize the benefit of a more liberal import policy 'even in the earlier stages.' " In other words the industrial worker and labor generally throughout the industrial East will share in the benefits of lowered agricultural commodity prices. The point lends strength to the thought often expressed that administrative attention runs to the factory employe of the Atlantic seaboard to a greater extent than to agriculture,

If the farmers of the west expected any degree of encouragement from the Secretary's annual report they are doomed to disappointment. The long and short of the mat-ter appears to be that agriculture need not look for materially higher prices although some obscure way agriculture is to becom better off. There will be less money to spend but it may be that the money will go farther

And somewhere back of it all there is ground for the suspicion that the farmer is being prepared against the day when he will have become not a farmer but a peasant.

### LAND-PLANNING

Back in 1931 and 1932 there was a great Back in 1993 and 1992 there was a great deail of intelligient and nonpartian talk about "national planning." Latterly the matter has been somewhat bedeviled by politics. It is refreshing to constructive minds to find the Science Advisory Board appointed two years neo reporting that planning at least as far as use of the country's land is concerned; is an economic necessity and not a political

There will be, of course, honest argun about the best way to handle critical land problems, but these should be based on facts, as determined by experts, without partisan bins. For the land, next to the people, is the most fundamental thing in this country.

The names on the advisory board give prestige to its recommendations. Well in-formed citizens have faith in such men as Professor Karl T. Compton of Massachusetts Institute of Technology, President W. W. Campbell of the National Academy of Sciences, Director Isaigh Bowman of the American Geographical Society, Charles F. Ket-tering the automotive genius, President John C. Merriam of the Carnegie Institute, Pro-fessor Robert A. Millikan of the California Institute of Technology, and others.

These big men unanimously agree that the nation must be more scientific and conservative in the use of its soil and other fundamental resources connected with it. Self-destructive practices must be avoided, threatened resources must be protected, climatic risks and other risks must be moderated, sub-marginal land must be withdrawn from cultivation, more good land must be brought under cultivation, and so on.

All this, of course, only after careful study and under expert guidance, with as little hardship as possible to any group involved.

INDUSTRIAL STATESMANSHIP The recent admonition of Alfred P. Sloar sident of General Motors, to American business leaders, is impressive:

"Industry," he says, "must further expand its horizon of thinking and action, it must assume the role of enlight. The continuation of the same should industrial statesmanship. To the school that it accepts its broad responsibilities, to that degree does it assure the maintenance of private enterprise."

He advocates the "theory of plenty" as opposed to the "theory of scarcity which has dominated our recent economic thinking and policies." He suggests a double yardstick: First, reduction of the prices of goods and services; second, a new balancing of national income through policies affecting wages, hours, prices and profits.
