NATIONAL CREDIT

Uncle Sam still has plenty of credit—pos-sibly too much for his own good. The last appeal for nine hundred million dollars, half in two and three-quarter per cent bonds and the rest in short-term one and one-half per cent treasury notes, brought offers of five

Money is still plentiful and cheap. The bankers who absorb these bonds and note don't like to see the government debt still rising, but have no better use for their funds. Besides, in spite of their protest against federal deficits, they still consider it their duty to see the government through,

It will be better for everybody when such calls are no longer necessary. Helpless de-pression victims have to be cared for; that s the obvious fact and the immediate need Everybody would rather see nine hundred million dollars, or the whole four billion five hundred million dollars offered, poured into private enterprise.

If it could be put into industry, the build-

ing industry for example, there would be little more need of the government's horrow-ing and spending. That should come in another year or two.

"JAPAN"NEXT "

The Japanese militarists now are proceeding slowly and cautiously in China. After making plans to take over five rich and popu-lous northern provinces, they drew back, assuming tentative control of part of one prov-ince and watchfully waiting. They cannot tell yet how far they dare go with impunity.

They planned their campaign when Mus-

solini-seemed-to-be-getting-away-with-his Ethiopian grab. If a European power could do that sort of thing, it was clear that an Asiatic power could, But lately Mussolini has Asiatic power could, But lately Mussolini has non-had-plate-platin-suffing-ac-line expected. When the League of Nations led by Great Britain cracked down on him, the Japanese Pascists decided to lie low for a little while. They might be next in line for discipline. And they do not want international discipline, through trade blockades or in any other

Britain, too, has been giving Japan some quiet advice. And now America has got into the game, Secretary Hull's warning, reinforcing the London warning, reminds Japan and all the world that not only has China sov-ereign rights, but many nations have rights in China which they are not willing to relinquish, Pressure of this sort may hold Jap-an for a while, at least, to her treaty obliga-

It is clear that the more strongly Italy is forced to respect international rights and world opinion, the easier it will be to get a square deal for China and safeguard our own interests in that country.

FOOD IN BOOKS

At a recent literary breakfast in New York the menu consisted entirely of dishes mentioned in the writings of Alexandre-Dumns and prepared according to his own recipes. This immediately suggests other possibilities. Gardens have been planted in Shakespeare's honor containing all the different plants and flowers mentioned in his plays. Why not a series of literary meals, with book-lovers cat-ing their way through their favorite nuthors

and discussing literature the while?


