



LINGERING

A good many months have elapsed since the Blue Eagle went out of business and the NRA was consigned to the New Deal scrap heap yet there are still nearly two thousand employes on the NRA payroll and the institution is quite as active as many another bureau of government born of expediency in the early days of the recovery program.

Eventually the organization will be turned over to the Department of Commerce and a means of doing this is now being studied.

What does this defunct organization and its nearly two thousand employes do now that it has no further official existence? It is engaged in preparing a history of the codes and a study of American Industry. The stories of something over a thousand codes will go into the archives when completed. To date about three hundred have been finished. The typewritten story of the lumber code

The voluntary code plan under which an abbreviated scheme of NRA existence until April first next was provided for has been virtually abandoned, only nine industries in all having submitted codes but there is still plenty of work to be done. The seven hundred odd code stories still uncompleted will take care of that.

One is inclined to wonder if money to be

spent for this sort of thing will continue for ever to roll into the Federal treasury. The National Recovery Act is today about as dead as anything could be but it refuses to fold up. It is much an entity of government now as it ever was.

Maybe it's all right but it should be re-membered that the Government is now spending at the rate of more than soven billion dollars a year and is taking in in revenues just a little more than-half-of-this amount. Not for ever can an annual deficit such as this be made up through the sale of government bonds.

MAKING SAFE DRIVERS


