Government Prepares For Speedy Payment Of Veterans' Bonus

In Second Of Two Statements, President Urges Former Service Men To Hold Bonds As 'Nest Eggs'

WASHINGTON, Jan. 27.—Quickly accepting an climactic senate vote of 76 to 19 as sealing the overthrow of his bonus veto, President Roosevelt today sent orders down the line to pay off the \$2,491,000 soldiers' bill as quickly as "accuracy will permit."

No word of disappointment or chagrin, no hint as to the possibility of new taxes came from the White House as the president's veto in a shocking bipartisan ballot—with a two-thirds majority never in doubt—declined to accept the president's disapproval of bill for immediate payment in \$50 cashable bonds. The house previously had voted 234 to 61 to override.

Commons Thwart In the second of two statements leading quickly from the White House, however, the president opened a drive to lessen the strain on the treasury by urging veterans that they should not cash their bonds but hold them as "nest eggs."

After a speedy arrangement of cash from the national companies of the three major veterans organizations, Mr. Roosevelt authorized a great release urging veterans to prevent "flattering away" of cash from the bonds.

Permanent advantage as opposed to wholly temporary pleasure (by the criterion), said the president, was the only way to get the bonus not cashed except for a useful purpose, and apparently taking cognizance of the spending spurge indulged in by some veterans, they were permitted to borrow up to 50 percent on their certificates in 1937.

First Rank Estimated Administration leaders late estimated that not more than one billion dollars will be needed to meet the first half of demands for cashing in the bonds, and the president apparently intended to keep the figure below that if possible.

Within a little more than two hours after the senate vote, Mr. Roosevelt said in his first statement that the treasury and veterans administration had been directed to pay as soon as possible. He warned

A feature of the tower system is that whenever dangerous driving is observed, the lookout will be able to "freeze" the road ahead by switching on a red light. At the same time loud speaker will call attention to the offense and direct motorcycle patrolmen to the car involved.

About Eight Miles Apart  
The first tower already has been erected near Burbank, Calif. It is a 10-foot-high, 10-foot-wide structure of concrete and steel, with a watch station in the center. It will be the base for the officers' motorcycle or car.

Other towers will be erected about eight miles apart.
