





# WEEVILS CAUSE SERIOUS LOSSES

Harvest Beans, Peas and Cow-peas Promptly After Maturity to Prevent Damage.

## TREAT SEED BY FUMIGATION

Kill Insects Before They Can Increase in Numbers and Carry on Destructive Work—Injurers Have Become Disastrous.

(Prepared by the United States Department of Agriculture.)  
The serious losses caused by bean and pea weevils—which amount to millions of dollars annually—are largely preventable, and by using a simple and valuable and successful means of the national food supply can be saved. No satisfactory artificial fumigant can be used on all weevils in beans, peas or cowpeas growing in the field, but they can be easily and effectively controlled afterwards if the necessary care is given.

The crop should be harvested as soon as possible after maturity, and the seeds thrashed, cleaned and treated by fumigation, heat or cold storage. In order to kill the weevils in them before they can increase in numbers and carry on their destructive work.

Weevils not only cause serious damage to peas, beans and cowpeas in storage but also in the field, and are responsible for a curtailment in the acreage planted in these crops. In some sections, particularly in the coastal regions of the middle Atlantic States, the weevil has carried on its work of destruction so successfully that crops have become discouraged and have the tendency to produce smaller crops.

Small rats, mice, and other rodents also cause serious damage to food crops. They infested seeds are worthless for planting. In one experiment on peas, 20 per cent of all the seeds were germinated, and of these 30 per cent were so badly injured that they could not develop into healthy plants.

### Harvest All Sealed

In gathering the crop, farmers are urged to harvest early, to leave no portion of it in the field, as seeds scattered on the ground or left in the field are liable to be infested there, and may carry the weevil over winter, and furnish a supply for the following season. The crop should be harvested as early as possible after reaching maturity, and the seeds thrashed or threshed and stored in sealed containers. If the seeds are to be stored in bulk, they should be deposited in the air, repacked into a heavy polythene gas tight immediately after the seed is thrashed, and stored in more generous use, though care should be taken that the air is not too dry, as this is injurious to the seed. The chemicals used at the rate of one quart to each 500 cubic feet of space to be fumigated, should be poured over the top of the seed, and fumigation should continue for from 24 to 48 hours.

### Killed by Heating

When there is only a small quantity of seed, the weevil may be killed by heating the seed in a sack or in a hot water bath. The water should be hotter than 120 to 140 degrees Fahrenheit. Heating seed in hot water causes damage to low temperatures, and if seed can be heated to 120 degrees Fahrenheit, it should be heated to 130 degrees Fahrenheit, but trouble from this point will result.

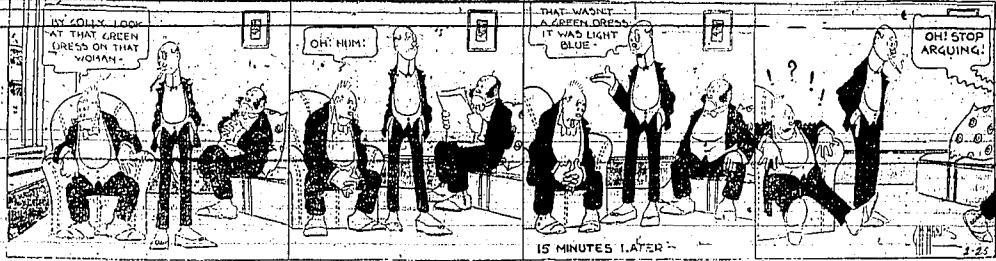
