Neutrals Coming to Paris in March

Robert J. Prev. (L. N. S. Staff Correspondent) - PARIS, Feb. 25 - Nothing will be done with the draft of the league of nations until President Wilson returns to Paris, it can be authoritatively stated today.

Efforts have been made by some of the delegates, notably the British, to secure consideration of the covenant by bringing the matter before the council of ten in the presidents absence. The American viewpoint, however, is that the president was so closely identified with the constitution that nothing should be done in his absence.

In view of this consideration, the postponing of neutrals to Paris to get statements of their position is being delayed until the return of Mr. Wilson.
