WILSON DENIES STATEMENT ON IRISH QUESTION

SAYS HE DID NOT SAY BRIN WOULD HAVE NO PART

Hitchcock Gave Some What Different Version

Nebraska Reads Statement by Senator that "Ireland Would Be Left at Mercy of England"

WASHINGTON, Feb. 23.—The published statement that President Wilson told members of the senate and house foreign affairs committees and the senate Irish league center that "the Irish question was a matter between Ireland and England and that I would not have any voice in the peace conference at Geneva" was vigorously denied by the white house this afternoon.

"The president wishes me to say that the statement in the foundation in fact is a deliberate falsehood, and he had a formal letter by Secretary of State to the effect that the white house statement is a gross misstatement of what was said at the dinner," he said.

Senator Hitchcock was attacking one of the reasons for violating the white house statement. "The president," he said, "has not only said that he has no voice in the peace conference but also that Ireland would be left at the mercy of England and Scotland."

Senator Hanna immediately demanded to know what the president said and Mr. Wilson stated that he had said "Ireland is a matter between England and Scotland."

Director General Hines has announced that he will not be asked to attend the peace conference at Geneva.

"The president told me that the Irish problem is a domestic one, it would not come under the jurisdiction of the league," he said.

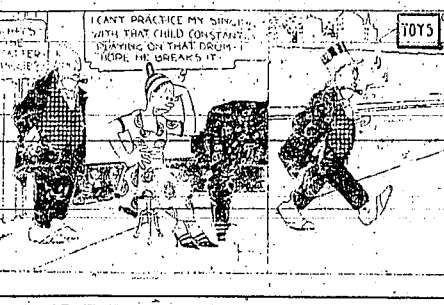
