ESSEX IS NEW ONLY IN NAME

HOW TO APPLY AUTO BEARINGS SAFELY IS TOLD

A. H. Campbell, Manager of Twin Falls Auto Company Gives Valuable Information on That Subject

There is still a great deal of misunderstanding in the matter of removing and applying anti-friction bearings. The reason for this is that which is not discovered until long after the repair man has finished his job, and is generally never traced to its source.

The removal and application of bearings is a delicate job which can easily be bungled. Carelessness on the part of the mechanic handling the bearings may result in costly trouble for the car or truck owner.

Bearings should never be driven in place by blows from an ordinary machinist's hammer applied directly to the bearing face or through the medium of a steel drift or blunt chisel, nor should they be removed by the use of "heat" or "grease" or metal tools, because the race members may be permanently sprung or deformed by this treatment.

Even the practice of driving them in place by pounding on the outer race with a piece of barbit or lead is not conducive to best results, the soft metal, while it may not mar the bearings, may result in the bearing being "cocked," sideways and is apt to cause a hot run on the motor.

A habit of lead use should be used, or some form of soft metal yoke which will distribute the hammer blows evenly. In all cases, where possible, the pressure applied to remove a bearing or apply it should be exerted directly against the portion that is in light fit on the shaft or in the inner race of the bearing that is to drive or light press fit on the shaft.

The outer race member is usually in the bearing. In most cases, it is the easily removed after a dowel pin or locking device is removed.

It is necessary to force the bearing off with a cone or driver, attaching a brass or ball-bit metal bar or shaft between the bearing and the shaft. The ball-bit metal bar is available in a block of wood will suffice, but must not hit the bearing against any one point on the bearing, as this will tend to crank it and will make it harder to drive off. Distribute the pressure around the entire circumference always leaving sufficient blow points diametrically opposite.

There are various good ways of removing bearings by simple mechanical means, such as wheel pullers. The use of such mechanicals is not only commendable, but results in valuable time saving and goes far to remove danger of damaging the bearings.

NOW IS THE TIME TO CLEAN COOLING SYSTEM PASSAGES

This is a good time of year to clean out the passages of the cooling system. After a year's service the walls of coils, tubes, jackets and other parts of the system are probably covered with a deposit of scale, which prevents the passage of heat. This is due to the fact that the rubber tubes from the radiator to the engine have an insulating film of calcium and blocks the passage of water.

When the cooling system is cleaned, it is necessary to use a power drill to remove the scale. A hand drill will probably make a weakly start. The wire should be confined in a conduit to obviate possibility of light chafing through.

FOR LEAKING GUIDES

When the valve stem guides leak, some oil may be sucked into the engine to cause stalling, which is especially bad at low speeds. Where such guides are used, the best remedy is to press out the old bushes and press in new ones.

The little jelly-like animals which the scientist calls Foraminifera warn so abundantly in the strata that they are called shells in some places because of a considerable part of the specimens which are left down on the sea bottom and which in those become beds of rock in a hard state.
