**Government Policy Outlined by Jones**

WASHINGTON, April 3.—Reconstruction rather than criticism should be the motto of the next congress in dealing with the further developments of the American merchant marine, Senator Jones of Washington, who is chairman of the committee on the senate commerce committee, declared in an "open letter" this afternoon to Governor Hiram E. Hildreth of the shipping board.

Jones said that he had read "with much interest" Hildreth's plan for the sale of the boats to private interests, under government supervision.

"Congress will meet before long," he wrote. "It should proceed promptly to the consideration of this important matter. I am chairman of the senate commerce committee, and soon as possible I shall ask the committee to proceed at once to consider and determine upon a plan for handling our shipping aid in the future development. The recommendation by the shipping board of a plan will consider and carefully measured by it, will aid the committee greatly in this work."

**PROPOSAL TO REGULATE AIR NAVIGATION**

International Regulations Forbidding Transportation of Cameras or War Supplies Suggested.

WASHINGTON, April 3.—International regulation for air navigation proposed in a report of the international commission of civil aeronautics, which the French ministry of war has created from the ministry of foreign affairs, says a dispatch received by the state department today from Council of League of Nations, Paris.

It is proposed to forbid the carrying of cameras, war supplies of any nationality on air flights, without special authorization and to allow the contracting governments to forbid private individuals of any nationality to fly over certain specified zones of their territory. Provisions are made for the classification and registration of all airships, whether planes, balloons, or dirigibles, the lists to be exchanged between the contracting governments.

It is also proposed to standardize the conditions under which aerial photography will be granted to machines and pilots. The report further says that provisions should be made for the standardization of lights on airships for route and driving regulations. It also suggests a number of dress airplanes which it is proposed to offer as a kind of an international code.

**Eugene V. Debs Asks Executive Clemency**

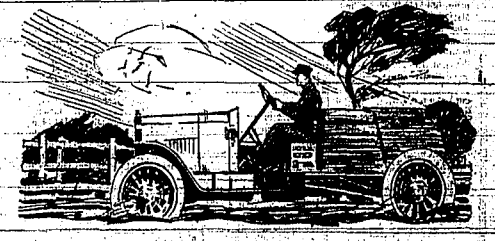

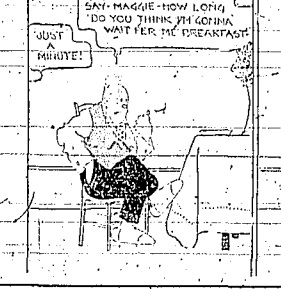

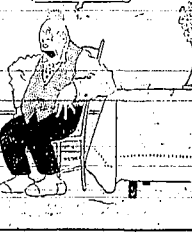
