BRAVEST MAN IN AMERICAN ARMY
COMPLIMENT BY TANK COMMANDER
BESTOWED UPON NEW JERSEY BOY

CAMDEN, N. J., April 11.—The bravest man in the American Army, according to a report of April 7, 1919, was lately awarded a decoration by the Patrol commander of the Third Battalion, Fourth Tank Brigade, American Expeditionary Force, Europe, and Commander of the Third and Fourth Tank Brigades, American Expeditionary Force, Europe, for his services with the Third and Fourth Tank Brigades, saving the life of Colonel Patton by dragging the latter into a shell hole after the latter had been wounded, directed the operation of the tanks and saved the whole brigade from annihilation.

"When the Tank Corps went over the top September 26 at Clermont-Ferrand west of Stoupeville, France, I was shot down and Joe dragged me into a shell hole. He was without doubt the bravest man in the American Army. I have never seen his equal."

Colonel then sent an order for the Tank Corps to play in the "H" and "I" had to be left for the presence; they were killed by a shell hole and were in that position.
